

Saturday August 3th Lat 32-49 N.
Long 52-06 W.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and Easterly wind at 2 P.M. got the whall long sight and start to catch at 9 o'clock is all in Woodroff took the head and part Blaker Middle night same at day light start work later part the same

Sunday August 4 Lat 33-00 N
Long 52-07 1/4 W

This day commence with very pleasant weather and wind from about S.E. the Sch. heading S and on different tacks the crew employed working on blaker at dark the same Middle part the same at day light the work is done and set for sail and saw Sch. Woodroff in sight and stood for her: wind from the same quarter:

Monday August 5th Lat 32-44 N
Long 52-24 W

This day commence with very pleasant weather and S.E. wind gameded the Sch. Woodroff at dark took in sail and hoist tow heading into the southerly: pumps and lights attended Middle part the same later part raised the school whall lowered boats down and got one the Sch. Woodroff have her boats down but she did not get any

Tuesday August 6th No. obs

This day commence with very pleasant weather and the Sch. Chasing the boats fast to the whall at 3 p.m. whall is long sight: rep the bathing gear and start to catch at dark get goe on deck and stimp caring get supper and set the whacks: pumps and lights attended Middle night the same at day light start bathing later part the same: Sch. Woodroff is in sight

Wednesday August 7th Lat 32-46 N.
Long 52-43 W.

This day commence with very pleasant weather and S.E. wind the crew employed bathing at dark got three send down the bathing gear and start on tidwork find one lamp hanging on the whall: lights and pumps attended Middle and later part the same

Thursday August 8th No. obs

This day commence with very pleasant weather and very light air from about S.E. the Sch heading into the westerly later on calm at dark the same the crew employed working on blaker pumps and lights attended Middle and later part the same
