

Wednesday August 21<sup>th</sup> Lat 33-43 N.  
Long 51-04 1/4 W.

this day commence with very pleasant weather and wind from about NW. the Sch. heading into the North by later on quite fresh: took down the foremast and hauled from the foremast put into sail pump at dark took in mainsail and topsail the wind is about W by S. the Sch. heading NW. pumps and lights attended Middle and later part rougher weather and fresh <sup>strong</sup> breeze from about W by S.

Thursday August 22<sup>th</sup> Lat 34-22 N.  
Long 51-39 1/4 W.

this day commence with <sup>strong</sup> breeze from about W by South the Sch. heading NW. raised School whalls lowered down and got 3: at 6 P.M. got the whalls along side the water & set the same pumps and lights attended Middle part the same. at day light started to lathering with squalls and rain later part got thru lathering the weather moderate down drizzly

Friday August 23<sup>th</sup>

this day commence with SW wind and rough weather and some rain the Crew employed cleared up the 3 heads and send down the lathering gear at dark took in mainsail set mantresail. the Sch. heading SW. by S. pumps and lights attended 4 P.M. started with Middle and later wind from the same quarter and the work still goes on

Saturday August 24<sup>th</sup> Lat 34-11 N.  
Long 51-27 W.

this day commence with very pleasant weather and westerly wind the Sch. heading NW. the crew still working on blatter at dark took in mainsail and set mantresail Middle night got thru boiling at day light set foresail and standing into westerly the crew employed stowing down the sail later part the same

Sunday August 25<sup>th</sup>

this day commence with very pleasant weather and wind from about NW by W. the Sch. heading N. at dark the same pumps and lights attended Middle and later part moderate weather and wind from the same quarter the Sch. have been on different tacks handling for the whalls but nothing have seen at this day

Monday August 26<sup>th</sup> Lat 35-06 N.  
Long 52-03 1/2 W.

this day commence with very moderate weather and NW wind the Sch. stands on different tack with all sail set. at dark took in mainsail set mantresail and have two on Starboard tack heading about W. by S. Middle night calm at day light wind from same quarter raised the School whalls bound into the SW. later part chasing the mat got fast and iron broke off
