this day comence with very pleasant weather and westerly wind the Sch. stands with all sail set. the boats chasing whalls at 3 15 p.m. boats got aboard at dark took in mainsail and topsail and hove two heading into the NW. Middle and later part the same

Wednesday August 28th Lat 35-23 N
Long 52-25 W

this day comence with very pleasant weather and westerly wind the Sch. standing with all sail set heading into the S. and W. later on raise the Schooll whalls bound w. lowered boats down but did not get them at dark took in mainsail set mantjesail and the Sch. heading about NW.

pumps and lights attended Middle and later part wind from same quarter and rough weather the Sch. heading into the S. and W. with reefed mainsail

Thursday August 29th Lat 35-42 N
Long 54-07 1/2 W

this day comence with fresh westerly wind and rough weather the Sch. heading into S. and W. with reefed mainsail at dark the same pumps and lights attended Middle night squalls took in mainsail at day light set it fresh breeze from the same quarter later part the same Sch. heading N.W. that is by the wind

Friday August 30th Lat 36-00 N
Long 55-42 1/4 W

this day comence with fresh westerly wind and choppy seas the Sch. steering NW with all sail set that is by the wind at dark the same took in mantjesail pumps and lights attended Middle and later squalls and rain

Saturday August 31st Lat 36-50 N

this day comence with fresh breeze from about W. and rough weather and some rain took in mainsail and foresail and got set for and mantjesail at dark moderate weather set sail and wind came from about N.N.E. the Sch. heading NW. by wind pumps and lights attended Middle and later part wind from the same quarter the Sch. steering NW. by W. course with all sail set

Sunday August 31st Lat 36-55 N
Long 55-08 1/4 W

this day comence with moderate weather and Easterly wind the Sch. steering NW course with all sail set at wind from the same quarter and weather looks squally pumps and lights attended Middle part squalls took in mainsail later better weather set it and mantjesail but soon took it in the Sch. steering NW course wind from the same quarter
