

Journal on Board Barque Maria &c, Rio
 Sun. July. 28th These 24 hours begins with
 pleasing winds and the Lee side of
 Pango and saw an account of vessels
 in sight at 2 P.M. spoke 5 Portuguese
 men of War, at 5 we took a Light breeze
 & stood off shore the middle part of fine
 breeze & spoke the Pango of Rantuchit & spoke
 visible at 6 P.M. worked up of Brava and at
 8 went on shore with our boat & ended the
 day Lying off (and on) Lat 14-52 S.
 Long 24-28 W.

Mon. July. 29th These 24 hours begins with moderate trades
 and at Laying of our bar to Brava at 2
 the boat came off and I went on shore to
 trade at 6 P.M. came off and stood off and
 on through the night at 8 P.M. went on
 shore to trade & at 12 came off with one
 boat load & ended that day & we left Little's
 Lat 14-27 S.
 Long 24-53 W.

Tues. July. 30th These 24 hours begins with moderate
 trades and the boat on shore at 1, had
 3 the boat came off and we made sail
 steering S.E. W. the fore & mainmast standing sail
 out at 8 and the lower standing sail the middle
 & latter part fine breeze Lat 15-31 S.
 Long 24-55 W.

Wed. Aug. 31st These 24 hours begins with fine
 trades from N.E. steering S. by E. the
 middle & latter part Light breeze from
 N.E. & ended these 24 hours Lat 11-53 S.
 Long 25-09 W.

Thurs. Aug. 1st These 24 hours begins with Light breeze
 from N.E. steering S. by E. the middle part
 variable winds from S.E. W. & took in standing
 sails & stood by the wind at 1. took ship
 heading S.E. & at 6 P.M. took to the S.W.
 & 2. sail in sight & the day ends. Lat 11-21 S.
 Long 25-58 W.

Continued
 Fri. Aug. 2nd These 24 hours begins with Light
 air from South E. steering by the wind
 N.E. W. the middle part moderate at 8
 P.M. a moderate breeze from W and
 shifted S.E. W. the latter part squalls of
 rain & ends Lat 10-50 S.
 Long 25-50 W.

Sat. Aug. 3rd These 24 hours begins with squalls of
 rain and a breeze from N.E. W. and steering
 South at 4 P.M. heavy showers of rain and took
 in the gallant sail at 5 and the fore topsails
 at 9 more moderate and made all sail with
 a light breeze from aft. steering S. the latter
 part the same Lat 9-41 S.
 Long 25-00 W.

Sunday Aug. 4th These 24 hours begins with moderate
 breezes from N.E. W. steering S. and a plenty
 of rain at 1 saw a ship steering the same
 course the middle part rainy and Light sails
 taken in the latter part pleasant weather
 & ended these 24 hours Lat 8-54 S.
 Long 24-20 W.

Mon. Aug. 5th These 24 hours begins with moderate
 breezes from N.E. W. steering S. the middle
 part pleasant at 5 P.M. squalls of rain
 & wind steering S. by W. the latter part squalls
 & ended these 24 hours Lat 7-40 S.
 Long 23-35 W.

Tues. Aug. 6th These 24 hours begins with fresh squalls
 of wind & rain & steering to S. W. at 4 P.M.
 put 2 reefs in the topsails at 8 more moderate
 & made all sail the latter part strong gale
 from S.E. W. steering by the wind in the night
 reef topsails & ends Lat 6-22 S.
 Long 23-10 W.

Wed. Aug. 7th These 24 hours strong gale from S.E. & S.
 heading S. by E. the middle & latter part the
 same & a ship in sight. - Lat 6-14 S.
 This day cut wind & a ship
 25 miles Long 21-10 W.
