

Journal On Board Barque Maria

Thursday These 24 hours moderate breezes from S. E. W. the 9. & stirring by the wind and a ship ahead the middle & latter part strong breezes from S. E. W. so ends. Lat = 5-14 N Long = 20-20 W

Friday These 24 hours strong gales from S. E. W. the 10. stirring by the wind S. E. by S at 6. P. M. saw a sail ahead the middle part moderate at 5 P. M. saw a Brig of War the latter part fine weather so ends. Lat = 4-29 N Long = 18-20 W

Sat. Aug These 24 hours begins with fine breezes from S. by W. and heading W. by S. at 7. P. M. took ship to the S. by E. at 8 P. M. took to the west S. West so the day ends with a plenty of fine Barks in sight Lat 3-54 N Long 18-50 W

Sun Aug These 24 hours begins with strong gales from S. E. stirring by the wind W. S. W. at 6 P. M. took ship to the S. E. & put a reef in the topsails at 10 Moderate S. Lat then but at 6 P. M. saw a Barque to wind and 9 we took to the Westward at 10 took to the S. E. so ends the day Lat 3-00 N Long 18-40 W

Mon Aug These 24 hours strong gales from the South the 13 stirring by the wind S. E. by S under single reef topsails at 4 P. M. took ship heading S. W. & a ship to leeward the middle part fresh gales at 7 P. M. began to break but the main held to fast our sails down so ends the day with fine weather Lat = 1-50 N Long = 19-35 W

Tues Aug These 24 hours fine gales from S. E. stirring by the wind and employed a stowing down our bil at 6 P. M. finished the middle & latter part fine breezes from S. E. & at 12 past one English Barque steering N. E. so ends the day Lat = 0-20 N Long = 20-24 W

Wednesday Aug These 24 hours strong trades from S. E. the 15 stirring S. E. W. & employed a fitting rigging the middle & latter part fine breezes and stirring by the wind employed a fitting rigging. Lat = 1-07 N Long 20-30 W

Thurs Aug These 24 hours moderate trades from S. E. the 16 stirring by the wind to the South & all hands employed about the rigging the middle part moderate at 6 P. M. squalls of rain & wind so ends Lat 2-24 N Long 20-37 W

Fri Aug These 24 hours fresh gales from S. E. the 17 stirring by the wind S. E. W. and all hands employed at fitting rigging the middle part the same & continues so ends the day Lat 3-50 N Long 21-10 W

Sat Aug These 24 hours strong trades from S. E. the 18 stirring by the wind & all hands employed a fitting rigging the middle & latter part fresh gales and the topsails single reef so ends Lat 5-56 N Long 22-50 W

Sun Aug These 24 hours strong trades from S. E. the 19 stirring by the wind under single reef topsails the middle & latter part more moderate & set topgallant sails so ends Lat 7-50 N Long 23-55 W

Mon Aug These 24 hours strong trades from S. E. and the 20 stirring by the wind S. E. W. the middle & latter part much the same Lat 10-01 N Long 23-55 W

Tues Aug These 24 hours strong trades from S. E. the 21 stirring by the wind at 1 saw a Breach & seen gal it & it proved to be a fine Bark & at 4 put her on her beam again the middle part squally and the latter part Lat 11-45 under single reef topsails so ends Long
