Mon. Sept. These 24 hours moderate breeze from S.E. steering S.W. at 4 P.M. took in sail & Luff to the wind heading S.W. by E. at 6 P.M. made sail steering S.W. & ends the day

Tues. Sept. These 24 hours moderate breeze from S.E. steering S.W. at 6 P.M. took in sail & Luff to the wind at 6 P.M. made sail steering S.W. & employed on the rigging & ends the day with fine trade

Wed. Sept. These 24 hours fresh breeze from East steering W. by N. at 6 P.M. shortened sail at 8 P.M. let out the reefs and so forth it being squally & ends the day
