 the 13 Strong gales from E. S. E. & under
 short sail standing to the East
 ward at 6 were ship and took in
 sail the middle & ~~little~~ part equally
 and at 8 A.M. made sail and standing
 to the South by wind Lat 18-10 N
 Long 36-10 W

the 14 These 24 hours come with strong
 breezes from E. and at 6 P.M. took in
 sail & were ship heading to the North
 at 8 A.M. made sail and so the day
 ends with Moderate breezes from the North
 Lat 18-15 N
 Long 36-15 W

the 15 These 24 hours comes with Moderate
 breezes from N. E. & steering to the westward
 at 10 P.M. heavy squalls of wind & rain
 from the South and took in sail & ~~have~~
 have then the middle part heavy gales
 and the latter part Moderate breezes from
 W. S. E. & steering by the wind Lat 17-5 N
 Long 36-20 W

the 16 These 24 hours come with Moderate
 breezes from the North and steering by
 the wind to the North West at 6 P.M.
 Light air and took in sail at 8 A.M.
 made sail & at 8 P.M. were ship steering
 N. and saw 2 sails in sight Lat 17-4 N
 Long 36-40 W

the 17 These 24 hours come with Moderate breezes
 from E. S. E. & steering N. at 2 P.M. spoke
 the Barque Jasper of N. Bedford 51 Tons
 but 50 kil. a large whale along side at
 6 took in sail at 8 A.M. made sail and
 at 8 saw 1 a Spinn Whale & Landed at
 10 for him & got past to him & he took
 2 lines from us so these 24 hours Lat 17-40
 ends in Chase of the whale Long 36-35 W

for Spinn Whale
 the 18 These 24 hours come with Moderate
 breezes from the Eastward and in Chase
 of a whale that we struck and at 8
 the Boats came on board with the Lark
 of 2 Lines & no whale, & we took in
 sail at 6 P.M. made sail & stood to the
 N. E. at 8 saw a whale & Landed but
 he was a young to pore so we came on
 Board to end the day Lat 17-13 N
 Long 36-44 W

the 19 These 24 hours come with Moderate
 breezes from E. S. E. and steering for
 a whale at 6 P.M. took in sail at 6 P.M.
 made sail and fine breezes but no whale
 so ends these 24 hours Lat 17-30 N
 Long 36-48 W

the 20 These 24 hours come with fine breezes
 from E. and steering about for whale
 and at 6 P.M. took in sail headed to the
 North at 8 A.M. made sail and the latter
 part equally & so the day ends Lat 17-04 N
 Long 36-56 W

the 21 These 24 hours comes with squalls of rain
 and wind & under short sail at 6 P.M. took
 in sail headed to the South the middle part
 equally at 6 P.M. made sail & then 24 hours
 ends with equally weather Lat 17-23 N
 Long 36-44 W

the 22 These 24 hours come with fresh gales
 from East and at 4 P.M. made Moderate
 at 6 took in sail headed to the N. E.
 at 6 P.M. equally & at 7 were moderate &
 made two sail at 8 equally and took it in at
 11 made it again & so end these 24
 hours Lat 17-12 N
 Long 36-40 W
