 Bark to windward so ended these 24 hours Lat 16-58
 Long 36-51

the 5 the 24 hours commenced with moderate
 breeze from S.E. & steering to the North
 at 6 P.M. took ship & shortened sail
 at 6 P.M. made all sail with a moderate
 breeze & so ended these 24 hours Lat 16-51 S
 Long 36-40 W

the 6 the 24 hours commenced with moderate
 breeze from S.E. & standing to the
 S.E. at 4 P.M. took ship to the North
 at 6 P.M. shortened sail & at 6 P.M. made
 sail steering to the North so the day
 ends nothing seen Lat 16-31 S
 Long 36-31 W

the 7 the 24 hours commenced with moderate
 breeze from S.E. & standing to the North
 at 7 P.M. took ship to the S.E. & short
 and sail at 6 P.M. made sail at 8 P.M.
 the gale & stood S.E. and so the day
 ends with a strong breeze Lat 16-59 S
 Long 36-21 W

the 8 the 24 hours commenced with moderate
 breeze from S.E. & steering to the
 wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M.
 were ship to the S.E. at 6 took in
 sail at 6 P.M. made sail & at 7 were
 ship & stood S.E. & a Brig in sight
 a strong S.W. so ended these 24 hours Lat 16-45
 Long 36-40

the 9 the 24 hours commenced with moderate
 breeze from S.E. & standing to the
 wind South at 4 P.M. took ship
 to the North & at 6 shortened sail
 at 6 P.M. made sail & stood to the Westward
 at 12 saw a sail to windward & left sea
 so ended these 24 hours Lat 17-14 S
 Long 36-48 W

the 10 the 24 hours commenced with moderate
 breeze & squalls of rain and standing to
 the South at 4 P.M. saw a Bark to
 windward with a whale along side, at
 6 took in sail at 6 P.M. made sail
 & stood to the North & saw the Bark
 Champion of West Port a cutting up
 whale & so ended these 24 hours Lat 17-14 S
 Long 36-52 W

the 11 the 24 hours commenced with fresh
 breeze from S.E. & standing by the
 wind S.E. at 6 P.M. took in sail at
 6 P.M. made sail again & stood to the North
 at 11 a strong breeze & a Brig & Bark
 of our sea at 12 took ship Lat 16-56 S
 Long 36-59 W

the 12 the 24 hours commenced with fresh
 gale from S.E. & steering S.E. at 6
 P.M. took in sail at 6 P.M. made sail
 & stood S.E. at 10 were ship to the
 S.E. & so ended these 24 hours Lat 17-46
 Long 36-54
