

Journal On Board Bark Maria  
Wed Nov the 14 These 24 hours commens with moderate  
breezes from the South E. at 4 P.M.  
within the middle part a fine  
breeze at 9 P.M. spoke the  
Brig William of the 5<sup>th</sup> full  
Round Horn and put letters  
on board at 10 Left here and  
continued 24 hours ends Lat 14-34 S  
Long 56-56 W

Thurs Nov the 15 These 24 hours commens with  
fresh breezes from S. E. W. and  
at 1 P.M. took in the main sail  
& gaff at 4 P.M. started sail at 9  
a heavy squall & close reef the main  
top sail the latter part squally & under  
head sail 24 ends Lat 16-15 S  
Long 57-58 W

Fri Nov the 16 These 24 hours commens with the squalls  
of rain & how to head East at 5  
P.M. saw a Brig to Leeward and the  
latter part moderate & made sail  
heading to the South 24 ends Lat 15-57 S  
Long 58-12 W

Sat Nov the 17 These 24 hours commens with moderate  
breezes from S. and at 5 P.M. spoke  
Brig Maria of Fall, China, 3<sup>rd</sup> part  
no. 11 at 6 took in sail headed  
to the South at 8 P.M. made  
sail starting S.W. at 9 spoke the  
Brig Thomas Hanslow 5<sup>th</sup> but 30  
& Bark Leda W. Part. 4<sup>th</sup> but 250  
and these 24 hours ends with fine  
weather Lat 16-52 S  
Long 58-23 W

Sun Nov the 18 These 24 hours commens with fine breezes  
from E. S. E. and at 6 took in sail at 6  
P.M. made sail and spoke a Bark  
from W. Part 2<sup>nd</sup> but 30  
the ends Lat 17-13 S  
Long 58-34 W

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Mon Nov the 19 These 24 hours commens with fresh  
gales & at 11 P.M. swept the topsails  
headed to the Eastward & sail in  
light at 6 how to at 6 P.M. set the  
Starboard & Staring to the Eastward  
& S. ends these 24 hours with a strong  
breeze Lat 17-45 S  
Long 58-55 W

Tues Nov the 20 These 24 hours commens with strong  
breezes from S. E. E. heading East 6  
P. at 8 P.M. took ship to the  
South & took in sail at 6 P.M. made  
sail heading East to the South & ends  
these 24 hours Lat 17-28 S  
Long 58-59 W

Wed Nov the 21 These 24 hours commens with fresh  
breezes from the South and starting  
to the Eastward at 6 P.M. took in  
sail at 1 P.M. made sail headed to  
the Eastward at 9 took ship to the  
North at 10 saw whaled & lowered and  
got men so ends these 24 hours Lat 17-51  
Long 58-30 W

Thurs Nov the 22 These 24 hours commens with strong  
breezes from S. E. E. a whaling whaled  
and at 5 P.M. came on board at 6  
took in sail headed to the North West  
at 8 P.M. made sail and at 9 started  
of West. at 9 hauled to the N. W.  
& saw a Brig cutting under our lee  
& sail in sight 24 ends these with  
strong gales Lat 17-31 S  
Long 58-40 W

Fri Nov the 23 These 24 hours commens with strong  
gales from S. E. and heading to the  
Eastward at 5 P.M. a squall & took  
in sail at 6 P.M. made sail and on  
a strong breeze headed to the S. W.  
so ends Lat 17-25 S  
Long 58-35 W
