 breezes from the North steering
 E by N. the middle part the
 same at 6 P.M. took out one of
 our pumps to fix at 8 next the
 topsail & there 24 hours ends with
 strong winds Lat 34-42 S
 Long 7-41 W

Mon Jan This 24 hours comm with strong
 the 18 winds from the North steering
 E by N. the middle part heavy gales
 & took in main sail, fifth fore top
 at 4 P.M. wind from S.W. & set the
 fore topsail it being raining the latter
 pleasant & made sun sail, Lat 34-13
 Long 4-60

Tue Jan This 24 hours comm with strong
 the 19 breezes from S.W. steering E by S at
 2 set the fore topmast standing sail
 at 6. Equally took him in & main
 topgallant sail & so forth the middle
 part the same the latter part more
 moderate & set the 4th topgallant sail
 so made these Lat 33-29 S
 Long 10-45 W

Wed Jan This 24 hours comm with fresh
 the 20 winds from S.W. steering E.S.E. the
 middle & latter part light breezes & all
 sail set & ends Lat 33-17 S
 Long 1-10 East

Thurs Jan This 24 hours comm with moderate
 the 21 breezes from S.W. steering E.S.E. with
 all sail cut the middle part light
 airs from E.S.E. at 6 P.M. sent down
 the fore topsail to murel, at 11. Jack
 ship to the South, & ends Lat 33-13 S
 Long 2-31 E

 Sun Jan This 24 hours comm with light
 the 22 airs from E.S.E. heading to the S.
 1832 all hands employed a mending sails
 at 1 P.M. bent the fore topsail &
 sent down the fore sail, at 6. bent
 it again. the middle part calm
 at 6 P.M. a light breeze, at 8. sent
 the mainsail down to murel, the
 latter part calm, Lat 33-34 S
 Long 3-15 E

Fri Jan This 24 hours comm with calm
 the 23 weather & employed a mending the
 mainsail at 6 P.M. bent him
 the middle & latter light airs from
 S.W. & employed a mending the
 main topgallant sail & fifth
 Lat 33-53 S
 Long 4-10 W

Sat Jan This 24 hours comm with light
 the 24 P.M. from S.W. steering S.E. employed
 mending the fifth at 2 P.M. finished
 the middle part a fine breeze from
 S.W. & set the 4th topgallant sail
 same Lat 33-44 S
 Long 5-51 E

Sun Jan This 24 hours comm with fine breezes
 the 25 from S.W. by S. steering S.E. the middle
 part foggy and wind from S.E. heading
 S.W. at 8 P.M. took ship to the
 South West. ends the 24 hours Lat 33-4
 Long 7-40

Mon Jan This 24 hours comm with moderate
 the 26 breezes from S.E. & V. Cloudy at 2 P.M.
 took ship to the Eastward the middle
 part foggy at 6 P.M. took ship to
 the South, weather thick. the latter
 calm & ends Lat 33-45 S
 Long 8-21 E
