with a fine breeze Lat 37-45 S

the 3 Strong breeze from S.E. E. Stirling
S.E. the middle part strong breeze
& under short sail at 8 P.M. home
to do ends these 24 hours Lat 38-05 S
Long 39-14 E

Mon Mar These 24 hours comm with strong
the 4 gales from S.E. E. at 6 P.M.
round to the Westward & Stirling
S.E. by E. the middle & latter part
moderate & off sail but Stirling
S.E. so ends these 24 hours Lat 38-20

East so ends these 24 hours Lat 39-55 S
Long 40-24 E

Sun Mar These 24 hours comm with strong winds
the 10 from East heading S.E. E. at 2 P.M.
more ship to the South East the middle
& latter part strong gales at 8 P.M. we
took the Steward out of Grand by his
acknowledgment of his fault so
the day ends with fresh gales &
lying to headed S.E. E. Lat 39-19 S
Long 40-00 E

Mon Mar These 24 hours comm with strong
the 11 winds from S.E. E. lying to heading
S.E. E. the middle part the same with
rain at 6 P.M. more soon sail it being
more moderate so ends these 24 hours
Stirling S.E. by E. Lat 39-54 S
Long 40-00 E

Tues Mar These 24 hours comm with fresh
the 12 breezes from the North Stirling S.E. E.
the weather raining the middle part
equally & latter part fine so ends
Stirling S.E. E. Lat 39-54 S
Long 40-00 E
