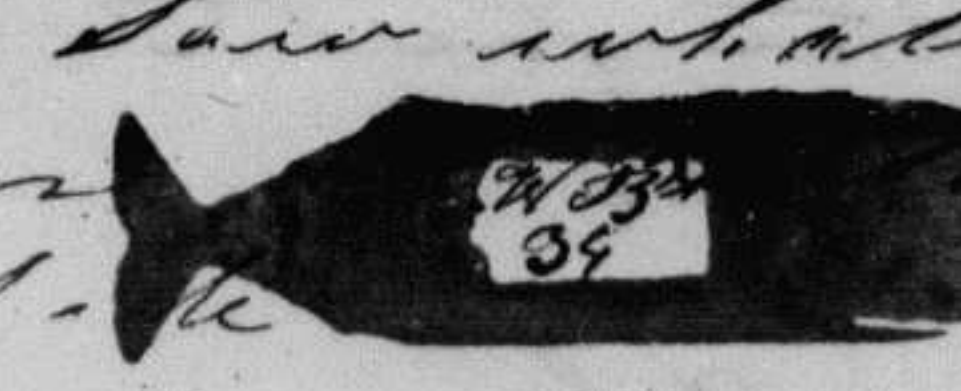
In the Indian Ocean
