 the 13 E. S. E. & E. S. E. heading to the South
 1848 Saw nothing & sawed down bar
 Lat 8-42 E.
 Long 41-59 E.

Tues Jan. These 24 hours light air from
 the 14 the E. Eastward heading to the
 S. E. at 6 A.M. saw whales lower
 got fast to 2 & at 12 high then
 along side   Lat 9-30 S
 Long 41-35 E

Wed Jan. These 24 hours light air from
 the 15 E. S. E. and at 1 P.M. began to
 to put at 4 finished & began to
 back latter part saw Black Fish
 S. wind then 24 hours
 Lat 9-50 S.
 Long 41-40 E.

Thurs Jan. These 24 hours light air &
 the 16 E. S. E. & fairing at 4 A.M.
 finished S. wind Lat 9-48 S.
 Long 41-43 E.

Fri Jan. These 24 hours light air from
 the 17 from S. W. & E. S. E. & stirring
 down bar S. wind Lat 9-56 S.
 Long 41-48 E.

Sat Jan. These 24 hours from breezes from
 the 18 S. E. & S. W. & stirring S. E. by E.
 at 10 A.M. saw the Commodore Island
 bearing S. S. E. S. wind Lat 10-56 S.
 Long 42-37 E.

Sun Jan. These 24 hours with light breezes from
 the 19 S. W. & E. stirring S. W. by W. the land
 in sight at 10 A.M. had a heavy
 squall from the S. W. & heavy rain
 S. wind

 Mon Jan. These 24 hours with moderate
 the 20 breezes from S. E. & S. W. the latter
 part fine weather S. wind
 Lat 12-57 S.
 Long 42-14 E.

Tues Jan. These 24 hours with squalls
 the 21 from S. W. & S. E. stirring S. S. W.
 the latter part squally & S. wind
 then 24 hours Lat 14-50 S.
 Long 41-50 E.

Wed Jan. These 24 hours with light
 the 22 breezes from the South stirring
 S. by W. & S. the latter part
 light breezes from the S. W.
 S. wind Lat 15-40 S.
 Long 41-28 E.

Thurs Jan. These 24 hours with
 the 23 light breezes from the S. W.
 heading S. E. & S. the latter part
 strong breezes & under double reef
 S. wind Lat 15-53 S.
 Long 41-50 E.

Fri Jan. These 24 hours strong gales from
 the 24 S. at 6 have the ship to 2 at
 10 P.M. split the foretopmast
 stay sail & main topsail it being
 a blizzard at 2 A.M. lost
 3 men & 2 boats & the wind
 from E. S. E. & latter part about
 the same

Sat Jan. These 24 hours with heavy
 the 25 gales from E. S. E. lying to under
 bare poles at 6 P.M. more moderate
 & had the fore & main stay sail
 all stay sail & main. latter part set
 the fore sail & fore top sail S.
 wind
