Saturday March the 15th 1862

First part fine light weather still steering N. by E. at 11 P.M. squally at Sunset Mid. clear Middle part fine weather at 5 P.M. took a very rain. Latter part fine weather saw nothing so ends the Day

Sunday March the 16th

First part cloudy & light winds from East to N.E. steering N. by E. Middle part light breezes at Daylight same rain squally Latter part rain squally saw nothing so ends the Day

Lat. 6° 45' 24" N. Long. 141° 19' 44" W.

Bar. 30.14 Therm. 74.0

Monday March the 17th

First part light air rain squally at 2 P.M. kept off & steering N. by E. at Sunset steering N. by E. Middle part light rain at 6 A.M. saw a school of Black fish at 4 A.M. saw a mother school of Black fish at 8 A.M. rain very hard at 10 A.M. clear so ends the Day

Lat. 6° 45' 24" N. Long. 141° 22' 30" W.

Tuesday March the 18th

First part light breezes at 2 P.M. saw a school of Black fish Chatham saw one of galapagos island Middle & latter part light winds at Daylight the Island bearing South dist 20 Miles so ends the Day

in the Pacific ocean look for Sperm. off the Isles

Wednesday March the 19th 1862

First part light breezes the Island of Chatham one of galapagos is bearing North dist 6 Miles light breezes Middle part calm at Daylight the Island of Chatham but 5 Miles at 5 P.M. saw a sail & several finbacks so ends the Day

Thursday March the 20th

First part light air & calm at 3 P.M. spoke a ship from Krigg at Sunset very light air steering to the East at Middle & latter part a but the same at Daylight the Island of Chatham bearing S.E. dist 20 Miles the Krigg still in sight so ends the Day
No al.

Friday March the 21st

First part light breezes from the S.E. heading to the East at 3 P.M. more ship to the South with light air & calm heading S.W. at Sunset the Island of Chatham bearing S.E. dist 30 Miles Middle & latter part calm at Daylight the Island bearing East dist 15 Miles so ends the Day
No al.

Saturday March the 22nd

First part calm at 2 P.M. took a light breeze from East at 3 P.M. calm again at Sunset the Chatham Island bearing N.E. dist 20 Miles Middle & latter part calm at Daylight the Island of Chatham bearing S.E. dist 20 Miles the Charles Island bearing S.E. dist 20 Miles the all in sight so ends the Day
Lat. 6° 45' 24" N. Long. 141° 22' 30" W.
