

Remarks on Board Bark Maria of New Bedford

Sunday March the 23rd 1862

First part calm at one P.M. took a light breeze from S.E. at 2 P.M. Calm again. the Wood's Island bearing East Charles's Island bearing W. Jarvis's Island bearing S. Barington's Island bearing S.W. Chatham's Island bearing S.E. Middle & latter part fine light breeze at Daylight the Wood's Island bearing S.E. dist 10 Miles the Charles's Island bearing S.W. the others S. lands at side to mid the Day. Settle by alt. 141 South.

Monday

March the 24th

First part fine light breeze from the South steering W.S.W. by S. V. W. by S. at Sunset the Wood's Island bearing S.E. dist 20 Miles Charles's Island bearing S.W. dist 15 Miles Middle & latter part very light breeze at Daylight Charles's Island bearing S.W. dist 15 Miles steering W.S.W. saw the Day. Settle by alt. 138 South.

Tuesday

March the 25th

First part Calm at 2 P.M. took a light breeze from S.E. steering W. by S. V. W. by S. Charles's Island bearing S. at Sunset saw South heads bearing N.E. W. dist 60 Miles Charles's Island bearing S.E. dist 20 Miles Middle part took very heavy squalls with rain. steering W.S.W. at 2 P.M. shifted to the wind heading South latter part fine pleasant to mid the Day. Settle by alt. 122 South.

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Wednesday March the 26th 1862

First part fine light breeze steering W. at Sunset the South heads bearing S.W. dist 25 Miles one of galapagos Island Middle & latter part light winds & calm at Daylight the West point of South head bearing S.W. dist 20 Miles many Black fish insight to mid the Day. S.E. alt.

Thursday March the 27th

First part fine light breeze from East steering W.S.W. at Sunset the West point of South head bearing S.E. dist one mile steering by the wind heading S.W. many Black fish insight Middle & latter part calm at Daylight a land 4 miles latter part calm saw nothing to mid the Day. S.E. alt.

Friday March the 28th

First part calm & rain steering S.W. at 4 P.M. kept off & steered S.E. the weather very cloudy Middle part steered by the wind heading from S.W. S.W. at Daylight calm saw a school of black fish saw 2 boats & got none to mid the Day. Settle by alt. 117 South.

Saturday March the 29th S. 122 South

First part light air took ship to the S.E. & E.S.E. at Sunset the land bearing S.W. dist 20 Miles Middle & latter part rain squalls at dusk saw the Charles's Island.
