Wednesday, May the 21<sup>st</sup> 1862  
First part steering S. 4/4 saw several fin backs at sunset took in Main Top Gallant sail & all up courses still steering S. 4/4 with East current at 10 P.M. heeled to the wind with head yards aback at 2 A.M. saw shoaled up black fish at daylight made all sail steering S. 4/4 saw 2 fin backs so ends the Day  
Satt 6, 6 1/2 miles South  
Longitude by Chron 119 35 West

Thursday  
Friday May the 22<sup>nd</sup>  
First part steered S. 4/4 saw porpoises at 11 P.M. steered S. 4/4 took in Gaff Top sail & Snigger Top Mast stay sail mid all & latter part fine light weather at daylight saw porpoises round the ship still steering S. 4/4 with all sail set so ends the Day  
Satt 6, 6 1/2 miles South  
Longitude by Chron 120 22 West

Saturday May the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
First part saw many porpoises going to the S. 4/4 & 2 fin backs at sunset took in all light sail & all up courses still steering S. 4/4 at 10 P.M. heeled to the wind heading to the South with head yards aback at daylight made all sail & steered S. 4/4 saw porpoises so ends the Day  
Satt 6, 6 1/2 miles South  
Longitude by Chron 121 01 West

Saturday May the 24<sup>th</sup> 1862  
First part fine pleasant weather at one P.M. wore ship & steering S. 4/4 saw porpoises at sunset took in Main Top Gallant sail & flying Jib. still steering S. 4/4 by 4/4 with North current Middle part light rain at 5 A.M. saw porpoises got one set Main Top Gallant sail & flying Jib. so ends the Day  
Satt 6, 6 1/2 miles South  
Longitude by Chron 120 54 West

Sunday May the 25<sup>th</sup>  
First part fine pleasant weather still steering S. 4/4 with all sail set saw to fin backs & porpoises at sunset took in Main Top Gallant sail & flying Jib. steering S. 4/4 with East current Middle & latter part fine weather at daylight & kept off & steered North saw nothing so ends the Day  
Satt 6, 6 1/2 miles South  
Longitude by Chron 121 11 West

Monday May the 26<sup>th</sup>  
First part fine pleasant weather steering South with all sail set at 2 P.M. saw 2 fin backs & porpoises at sunset took in Main Top Gallant sail & all up Main sail & heeled to the wind heading S. 4/4 under hole Top sails & fore sail Jib. & spanker Middle part fine light weather at 2 P.M. wore ship to the South at daylight made all sail saw many fin backs & porpoises so ends the Day  
Satt 6, 6 1/2 miles South  
Longitude by Chron 121 20 West
