

Remarks on Board *Barb Marie* of New Bedford

Monday June the 2nd 1862

First part employed to clear up
I. Commenced hauling & hauling reefed the
top sails & took in Gill & spanker &
wore ship to the South Middle part
the same at 4 am. to clear away the heads
still employed hauling at 10 am
wore ship & steered North so much
the Day Satt by abt 11th South
Longitude by Chron 121° 08' West

Tuesday June the 3rd

First part still employed
hauling at 11 am. set haly Gaff sail, & flying
Gill & Gaff Gaff sails still steered
Middle part very light wind still
steering to the North still employed
hauling Satter part a bit the same
at 4 am. saw a small white water the
proved to be sperm whales at one
lower the boats at 3 pm. the Waist
Boat stuck at sunset got him along
side Satt by abt 26 miles South
Longitude by Chron 121° 46' West

Wednesday June the 4th

First part still the whales
insight at one lower at Boats at
3 pm. the Waist Boat stuck at sunset
got him along side still employed
hauling at 10 pm. finished hauling lay by the
Whale at 4 am. commenced cutting at 10 am.
finished cutting & commenced to clear up so much
Satt by abt 19 miles S Longitude by Chron 121° 13' West

in the Pacific ocean. Looking for sperm Whales

Thursday June the 5th 1862

First part still to clear up at
2 pm. commenced hauling to gain heading to
the South Middle & Satter part very
light air still employed hauling
at 4 am. wore ship to the North still
employed hauling saw Porpoise sounds
the Day Satt by ~~abt~~ 34 miles S
Longitude by Chron 121° 29' West

Friday June the 6th

First part commenced with
very fine weather still employed hauling
at 11 am. finished hauling still steering to
the North at Day light wore ship to the South
& commenced breaking out to stowing
down side so much the Day Satt
Satt by abt 4 miles South
Longitude by Chron 121° 46' West

Saturday June the 7th

First part employed stowing
down the side still heading to the South
at 3 pm. saw white water Middle part
fresh breezy at Day light commenced
stowing down again at 10 am. leach still
employed stowing side so much the Day
Satt by abt 24 miles South
Longitude by Chron 121° 46' West

slow down about 10
700 miles
