

Remarks on Board Bark Maria of New Bedford

Wednesday June the 25th 1862
First part employed cooping
aile saw nothing but small fish
at sunset wore ship to the South
under half Gaff sails, G.L. & spunkier
heading to the S by East at midnite wore
ship to the N.E. at Daylight commenced
breaking out to staid aile with fresh
breezy & squally, saw nothing still imple-
loyed staid down the aile so ends the Day
Satt by abt 1 mile South
Longitude by Chron 131° 41' West

Thursday June the 26th
First part employed staid down
aile & wore ship to the South at 3 P.M.
finish staid down the aile at 4 P.M.
double reefed the Gaff sails & head
ing to the South staid aile at 11
P.M. wore ship to the N.E. at 5 A.M. wore
ship to the South at 6 A.M. saw ship
May ann steering to the N.E. so ends
the Day Satt by abt 15 miles South
Longitude by Chron 125° 50'

Friday June the 27th
First part employed set up shuk
at sunset double reefed the Gaff sails
& tarheel ship to the N.E. at 5 A.M. wore
ship to the South at 6 A.M. saw May ann
fairharm at 8 A.M. she saw a whale
at 10 A.M. we saw them spouting so
ends the Day Satt by abt 4 miles South
Longitude by Chron 122° 28' West

in the Pacific Ocean. Cruising for Sperm Whales

Saturday June the 28th 1862 N Street
First part laiver the 2 Boats at
2 P.M. the Waist Boat staid at 2 P.M. can-
along side at 3 P.M. the other Boats can-
cleared with out sweeps luffed to the wind
heading N.E. lay by the whale at Daylight
commenced cutting at 3 A.M. finish cutting
& wore ship to the South & commenced clea-
up the head at Maridean. Commenced
boiling saw Porpoises so ends the Day
Satt by abt 21 miles South
Longitude by Chron 122° 09' W

Sunday June the 29th
First part employed Liviling
set flying G.L. under double reefed
Gaff sails saw Porpoises at sunset still
unemployed Liviling with fine weather
at midnite locate in flying G.L. at 3
A.M. finish Liviling at 4 A.M. tran-
the reefed out the Gaff sails saw
nothing so ends the Day
Satt by abt 14 miles South
Longitude by Chron 122° 29' W

Manuel Sylvia
Monday June the 30th
First part tarheel ship to
the N.E. saw small white water
at 4 P.M. tarheel again & unployed
cooping aile at sunset tarheel again
& double reefed the Gaff sails at midnite wore
ship to the South at 10 A.M. saw 2 sails saw 2
Porpoises & black fish so ends the Day
Satt by abt 16 miles South Longitude by Chron 122° 15' W
