Remarks on board Carl Maria of New Bedford

Tuesday August the 12th 1862
First part more moderate turn the reefed
out the fore top sail still very thick & cloudy
steering E. by S under fore top sails courses & fil.
& shankers at half past 11 P.M. down to reefed
fore top sails fresh breezes & cloudy latter
part cleared East at half past 11 P.M. turn
reefed out the fore top sail so much the day
Satt by Ast 45 miles North
Long by Ast 81 1/2 10 West

Wednesday August the 13th
First part very thick still fresh
breezes from S. cleared E. by N. at Sunset
took in main top gallant sail & flying
fil. & all up main sail & spinnaker &
looking out for the land at daylight
saw the land saw 5 sails at Maridan
came to anchor 4 or 5 miles so much the day

Thursday August the 14th
First part employed clearing out
employed fil long water so much the day

Friday August the 15th
At daylight went shore &
got of a raft water at 9 A.M. com-
menced starting down so much the day

Saturday August the 16th
First part employed starting down
water at 2 finish

Sunday August the 24th 1862
First part got under way & stood
out working up to point
Satt 37 miles North
Cape Saint Francis bearing E. dist
Monday August the 25th 18 miles

fine weather in show Satt by Ast 10 miles
North

Tuesday August the 26th
First part fine pleasant weather
still working up at 6 P.M. tacked of show
at 4 A.M. tacked in show at 10 A.M. tacked
of show so much the day Satt by Ast 21

Wednesday August the 27th
Still working up the coast at
3 P.M. on beam flying fil. at Sunset tacked
of show middle part fine pleasant weather
at daylight tacked in show at 9 A.M. on beam
now flying fil. & main top mast stay sail
& gaff. top sail so much the day
Cape Florida bearing E. dist
10 miles

Thursday August the 28th
Still working up the coast at Sunset
tacked of show Cape Loring bearing S. W.
dist 9 miles the ship heading W. by N. at 9 P.M.
took in fore top gallant sail & mizzen top
mast stay sail middle part the ship
head W. by N. at daylight tacked in show
at Maridan the point 11 miles bearing
S. E. dist 12 miles so much the day
