

Remarks on Board the Bark Albatross W. B. Thompson Master

Thursday November the 20<sup>th</sup> 1862

First part employed in the ship duty, heading S. by E. with heavy sea and mild air & latter part strong winds from E. S. E. & Squalls took in all light sails & double reefed the Topsails the weather very cloudy the ship heading from S. to S. E. the log shows strokes in 24 hours 10 ends N. O. 0. 0.

Friday, Nov the 21<sup>st</sup>

First part calm mixed with very squalls & strong winds & cloudy heading from S. to S. E. under double reefed Topsails Middle part moderate & cloudy set whole Topsails at 6 A.M. set main Top Gallant sails & flying jib at 7 A.M. heavy squalls & strong winds took in the light sails & double reefed the Topsails still blowing on the ship heading S. E. the log shows strokes in 24 hours 10 ends the day, lat by obs 16° 15' South long by Chron 129° 55' West

Saturday November the 22<sup>nd</sup>

First part squalls & strong winds & heavy sea on heading S. E. under double reefed Top sails & lower jib & spinnaker still blowing fresh middle & latter part strong winds from the East heading S. by E. at 9 A.M. set whole Topsails & flying jib the ship still heading same strokes in 24 hours 10 ends lat by obs 14° 14' South lat by Chron 128° 18' West

Bound up to Napasua

Sunday, Nov the 23<sup>rd</sup> 1862

First part set main Top Gallant sail at 2 P.M. took in main Top Gallant sail & flying jib at sunset double reefed Top Topsails heading S. by E. Middle part moderate latter part set all sail steering by the wind heading S. E. so ends the day, lat by obs 19° 45' South long by Chron 128° 03' West

Monday, Nov the 24<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh breezes took in Top & main Top Gallant sail steering by the wind heading S. E. Middle part moderate breezes latter part set all light sails the ship heading S. E. by the wind so ends the day, lat by obs 21° 59' South long by Chron 127° 20' West

Tuesday, Nov the 25<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh breezes took in the light sails & set again heading S. E. by the wind Middle & latter part fine & pleasant weather steering S. E. saw the Labeledgeth Island strand one of Myzmen showed at daylight squalls at Marickan saw Labeledgeth Island leaving S. E. by 4 P.M. dist 9 miles so ends the day, the ship shows strokes in 24 hours lat by obs 24° 16' South long by Chron 123° 10' West
