

Remarks on Board the Bark Maria of New Bedford

December the 2^d 1862

Tuesday, first part cloudy & light squally & fine breeze at 11 pm took in main gallant studding & lower studding steering E by S at 9 pm took at light rain squally middle part more moderate set all the studding, latter part light breezes from N. W. steering E by S with all Tacking sail set the ship Leakes from 800 to 1000 strokes in 24 hours so ends the day, Lat by obs 30° 28' South Long by Chron 119° 11' 41" West

Wednesday, December the 3^d

first part fine pleasant weather steering E by S with all ~~set~~ sail set at 6 pm set for gallant studding middle & latter part fine light winds steering E by S & E S E latter part employed to clean main & mizzen shivers so ends the day, the ship Leakes the same Lat by obs 31° 18' South Long by Chron 115° 14' 41" West

Thursday, December the 4th

first part employed to clean mizzen shivers steering E by S with all sail set the wind from the N. E. & middle & latter part fine breezes from the North W. employed the ship Leakes 800 strokes this 24 hours so ends the day, Lat by obs 32° 18' South Long by Chron 113° 01' 41" West

Account up to Magra River

Friday, December the 5th 1862

first part fine pleasant weather steering E by S all sail set the wind from the N. W. middle part fine breezes from N. W. latter part light winds steering E by S with all Tacking sail set the ship Leaking the same so ends the day, Lat by obs 32° 51' South Long by Chron 111° 05' 41" West

Saturday, December the 6th

first part fine light breezes from the N. W. steering E by S with all Tacking sail set at 8 pm took in the studding the weather very cloudy at midnite the wind all to the East the ship heading to the N. E. took in all light sails & set again with thick weather the ship Leakes 800 strokes this 24 hours so ends the day, Lat by obs 32° 41' South Long by Chron 109° 50' 41" West

Sunday, December the 7th

first part thick weather steering by the wind heading N. E. at 3 pm took the ship to the S by E at 3 pm took the ship to the East latter part fine pleasant weather at 9 am set for gallant studding the ship Leakes 800 strokes this 24 hours so ends the day, Lat by obs 32° 00' South Long by Chron 108° 58' 41" West
