

Remarks on board the Bark Mission of

Monday March 10th 1836
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.W. with fine pleasant weather ship heading West were ship heading S.E. at day light made sail at 1/2 9 AM steered East middle part light breezes at 12 1/2 P.M. luffed up E.S.E. and set the fore top gullion sail, at 2 P.M. wind from the off S.W. at 3 1/2 P.M. saw a sail to the windward sun down took in sail & luffed by the wind heading S by W. latter part wind & weather much the same so ends this day. Lat by Obs 633 S Long by Chron 832 E

Tuesday March 11th
These 24 hours begins with moderate breeze from the S.W. at day light made sail at seven AM held off E by S at 9 1/2 9 AM saw a sail to the leeward middle part fresh breeze at 12 1/2 steered North at 4 P.M. kept off for the vessel at 5 1/2 P.M. bore away the Starboard Board & the Capt. went on board it proved to be the Nordaquest of Westport with 20 bbls of sp. gummed until 3 1/2 P.M. at sun down took in sail heading S.E. latter part light breezes from the S.W. so ends this day. Lat by Obs 633 S Long by Chron 1020

Wednesday March 12th
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. ship heading S.E. at day light made sail & kept the off S.E. middle part fresh breeze at 12 1/2 P.M. steered East, at sun down took in sail & luffed by the wind on the Starboard took ship heading W. by W. latter part much the same so ends this day. Lat by Obs 633 S Long by Chron 1020

Bedford Alfred C Davis Master 1836

Thursday March 13th 1836
These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the W.E. with fine weather ship heading N.W. at 12 AM were ship heading South at day light were ship & made sail heading N.W. at 1 P.M. saw a sail off the weather bore heading to the Westward, during the day saw several fire ships middle part fresh breezes at sun down took in ship and took in sail except the top sail, gib & spanker ship heading South by East & a bark to the windward heading the same way latter part wind & weather much the same so ends this day. Lat by Obs 618 S Long by Chron 1213 E

Friday March 14th
These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. with fine weather ship heading S.E. at day light made sail, saw the Bark Mattapoisit off the weather beam middle part light breezes, at 12 1/2 P.M. commenced breaking out water in the main hatch way at 2 P.M. finished at sun down strong breezes took in sail heading S.E. Mattapoisit of the weather quarter heading the same way latter part much the same so ends these 24 hours. Lat by Obs 618 S Long by Chron 1400 E

Saturday 15th
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.W. ship heading South at day light made sail saw the Mattapoisit off the weather quarter heading to the Eastward, at 5 1/2 P.M. held off E.S.E. at one P.M. steered East at sun down took in sail & luffed by the wind heading South middle & latter part much the same so ends this day. Lat by Obs 618 S Long by Chron 1400 E
