Friday June 6th 1836
These 24 hours begins with light breezes
from the S.W. & pleasant ship heading
S.W. at day light set all sail. At half past
pleasant wind from back at 1 P.M. steered
S.E. at sun down shorten sail & luffed
by the wind heading S.E. by S. Latter part
pleasant at 11 P.M. wind ship heading S.W.
Lat by Obs 3,13 S
Long by Chron 10,04 E

Saturday June 7th
These 24 hours begins with moderate
breezes from the South & pleasant ship heading
W.S.W. at day light were ship and made all
sail wind from the S.W. ship heading S.E.
at 8 1/2 A.M. saw a hump back at 9 1/2 A.M.
lowered the boats the third boat struck & raised
at 11 1/2 A.M. gave up the chase came on board
braced foreward heading S.E. at sun down
took in the light sails ship heading S.E.
Latter part pleasant wind from the S.W.
ship heading S.E. at 12 P.M. were ship and
hauled up the courses Lat by Obs 3,23
Long by Chron 10,30

Sunday June 8th
These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from
the S.W. & pleasant ship heading W.S.W.
at day light set all with puffing winds from
S.W. off to S.W. at 5 1/2 A.M. took ship
heading S.E. at 9 1/2 A.M. spoke the Brig Excellency
Captain Adams of Boston private trading
7 months out 120 24 all told Latter part
wind from the S.W. ship heading
S.E. at sun down shorten sail
Lat by Obs 3,29 S
Long by Chron 10,24 E

Monday June 9th 1836
These 24 hours begins with light breeze
from S.W. by W. & pleasant ship heading S.W.
with all sail set at day light saw sail
Middle part pleasant watch employed in
breaking and for water in the main hatch way
at 2 P.M. wind from the S.W. backed ship
heading West at 4 P.M. steered off W.S.W.
at sun down shorten sail & luffed by the
wind heading West with 3 sails in sight
Latter part light air from the S.W. ship heading
S.E. so under this day Lat by Obs 3,08 S
ship heading West Lat by Obs 3,08 S
Long by Chron 10,28 E

Tuesday June 10th
These 24 hours begins with moderate
breezes from the S.W. & pleasant ship
heading S.E. at day light set all sail
two sails in sight Middle part pleasant
wind light & puffing from S.W. to S.W.
ship heading from S.E. off to S.E. with
2 other sails in sight at sun down shorten
sail ship heading S.E. two sails in sight
Latter part pleasant with light air & calm
Lat by Obs 3,11 S
Long by Chron 10,21 E

Wednesday June 11th
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from
the S.W. & pleasant ship heading S.E.
at day light were ship & set all sail ship
heading S.W. by S. two sails in sight Middle part
pleasant 3 sails in sight at 1 1/2 P.M. backed
ship heading S.E. by S. at sun down shorten sail
ship heading S.W. Latter part moderate
wind from the S.W. ship heading
S.W. Lat by Obs 3,14 S
Long by Chron 10,14 E
