

Remarks on board the Bark Marion of

Monday June 30th 1838

These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant
breezes from the SSW & pleasant ship heading
SE with all sail set 4 or 5. No tracked ship
at day light 4 sails in sight. Middle part
pleasant saw porpoises fin backs & saw the
Bark Isabella chasing hump backs at sun
down tracked ship & Johnston with ship heading
SE. Latter part light breezes & pleasant

Lat by Obs 54° 15' N

Long by Chron 102° 21' E

Tuesday July 1st

These 24 hours begins with light breeze
from the SSW & pleasant ship heading
SE at day light set all sail & went ship
steering by the wind 4 sails in sight.
Middle part Moderate breezes saw hump
backs at 11 P.M. passed to the windward
of the Bark George & Mary at 2 1/2 P.M.
steered off ENE at 4 P.M. buffed by
the wind from the South heading SE
at sun down ^{short} sail Latter part fresh breezes

Lat by Obs 6° 15' N

Long by Chron 93° 54' E

Wednesday July 2nd

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes
from the SSW & smoky weather ship
heading SE at daylight set the courses gab &
spanker & set gaff sail at 6 3/4 A.M. steered
off East during the day saw 4 sails. Middle part
fresh breezes at 9 P.M. took the main top gall
sail main sail saw hump backs at 4 kept off
for the Brig Escorted at 1 P.M. buffed by the
wind at 5 P.M. spoke & gained with her were
ship & took in sail at 10 P.M. finished gaming
and passed forward heading SE at sun much the
same
