

New Bedford Alfred C Davis Master 1846

Thursday July 10th 1846

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the
S W & pleasant ship heading W N W at day
light set sail at 6 1/2 A M steered off N W
Middle part pleasant at 12 1/2 M luffed
by the wind, at sundown tacked ship & shorten
sail ship heading S E, five sails in sight
Latter part much the same Lat by Obs 40 55
Long by Chron 104 6

Friday July 11th

These 24 hours begins
with light breezes from the S W & pleasant
ship heading S E at day light set sail
saw five sails at 8 A M tacked ship
Middle part pleasant at 2 P M tacked again
at 5 P M gamed with the Bark Globe of New
Bedford Capt Tripp 11 months and 30 days 17 1/2
in company with the Bark Cathleen at 8 P M
finished gaming braced foreward heading S E
ends these 24 hours Lat by Obs 41 16
Long by Chron 105 12

Saturday July 12th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the
S W ship heading S E at day light steered off
N E the Bark Cathleen & Globe in sight
Middle part pleasant at 12 1/2 M steered N E
4 sails in sight at 3 1/2 P M the hump backs
at 4 lowered the boats & chased at sundown came
on board & took in sail ship heading N E, Latter part
much the same Lat by Obs 42 05
Long by Chron 106 00
