

Remarks on Board the Bark Mariner of New

Sunday July 13th 1850

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. and pleasant ship heading S.E. at day light set sail & steered off N.E. Midday past pleasant, at 12^{1/2} M saw a hump back at 1 P.M. reversed the Boat & the Starboard Board struck at 3 P.M. took him along side at 3^{3/4} commenced cutting. Latter part at 7^{1/4} P.M. finished cutting at 8^{1/2} M the watch the rest employed in clearing away ship heading E.S.E. at 10 P.M. commenced boiling

Monday July 14th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the S.W. ship heading S.E. the weather cloudy & watch employed in cutting & boiling blubber at daylight set the light sails at 1 A.M. wore ship & steered N.W. Midday past fresh breezes pleasant saw the brig Excellent at 10^{1/2} A.M. luffed by the wind heading W. at sundown took ship & took in the light sails ship heading S.E. by S. Latter part wind & weather much the same so ends this day boiling blubber

Tuesday July 15th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from S.W. & fine weather ship heading S.E. at 2 A.M. finished boiling at day light made sail watch employed in clearing decks saw a hump back going to the leeward Midday past pleasant breezes from the S.W. at 12^{1/2} M steered off E.S.E. at sundown shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading S.S.E. Latter part much the same

Bedford Alfred C Davis Master 1850

Wednesday July 16th 1850

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. & pleasant ship heading S.W. at day light set sail 3 sails in sight. Midday past light breezes at 1 P.M. spoke & gained with the Bark Sacramento of Westport Captain Snow 21 months and 5 or 6 years ago at sundown shorten sail Latter part pleasant at 7^{1/4} P.M. finished gaming brace foremast heading South light air from the W. & W. Jones much the same

Thursday July 17th
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the South wore ship heading W.S.W. & pleasant at day light set sail, 2 sails in sight. Midday past pleasant & buffing breezes, at sundown shorten sail & backed ship heading S.E. by S. Latter part pleasant

Long by Obs 10, 18 E

Friday July 18th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. & pleasant ship heading S.E. at daylight set sail & steered N.W. by N. Midday past pleasant at 12^{1/2} M steered North at 4 P.M. luffed by the wind & spoke the gained with the brig Excellent watch employed in stowing down hump back at 7^{1/4} P.M. finished gaming brace foremast & took in the main top gallant sail ship heading West

Saturday July 19th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. & pleasant weather at day light set sail steered off N.W. Midday past pleasant at 12^{1/2} M steered W.S.W. at sundown backed ship & took in sail ship heading by the wind S. Latter part fresh breeze much the same
