

Remarks on board the Bark Mission of Mass

Sunday July 27th 1836

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. & pleasant weather ship heading S.E. with all sail set. At 6 1/4 A.M. backed ship heading W. Middle part pleasant breezes & sundown backed ship heading S.E. Latter part wind & weather much the same.

Lat by Obs 44° S
Long by Chron 71° E

Monday July 28th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. ship heading S.E. with all sail set with fine weather. Middle part watch employed in painting the Larboard boat. Latter part pleasant with light winds from the S.W. by W ship heading S by East.

Lat by Obs 45° S
Long by Chron 72° E

Tuesday July 29th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. & pleasant weather ship heading S.E. with all sail set. Middle part light airs & calms watch employed in painting the waist. Boat saw two sails & saw hump backs at sundown shorten sail ship heading S.E. two sails in sight. Latter part wind & weather much the same.

Long by Chron 73° E

Wednesday July 30th

These 24 hours begins with light airs from the South & pleasant weather ship heading S.E. & at daylight wore ship & set sail ship heading W.S.W. two sails in sight. Middle part pleasant with squalls & squalls at 1 P.M. steered off with watch employed in cooping in paper at 2 P.M. (even) shorten sail & backed by the wind heading S.W. Latter part light airs & calms at 8 P.M. from W.S.W. passed around ship heading South. Lat by Obs 47° S
Long by Chron 74° E

Bedford Alfred C Davis Master 1836

Thursday July 31st 1836

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the W. by W ship heading S.E. with pleasant weather at day light set sail & steered off. Edd one sail in sight. Middle part pleasant breezes from the S.W. two sails in sight at sundown shorten sail & backed by the wind heading S.E. one sail in sight. Latter part light breezes.

Lat by Obs 48° S
Long by Chron 75° E

Friday August 1st 1836

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. & pleasant ship heading S.E. At daylight wore ship, one sail in sight. Middle part light airs & calms saw fin backs & killies at 8 A.M. lowered the Larboard boat & changed at 10 1/2 same on board ship heading West watch employed in breaking out for water. At sundown shorten sail & backed ship heading S.E. one sail in sight. Latter part wind & weather much the same.

Lat by Obs 49° S
Long by Chron 76° E

Saturday August 2nd

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.W. ship heading S.E. & pleasant weather at daylight wore ship & made sail ship heading W.S.W. Middle part light baffling breezes one sail in sight saw fin backs. Latter part pleasant breezes from the S.W. by W ship heading W by S with all sail set ends much the same.

Lat by Obs 50° S
Long by Chron 77° E

Sunday August 3rd

These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant breezes from the South and pleasant weather ship heading W.S.W. with all sail set. Middle part fresh breezes from the S.W. at 12 1/2 A.M. took a ship heading S.E. by E saw hump back. Latter part wind & weather much the same.

Long by Chron 78° E
