St Helena Sunday August 31st
These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant from the
S.E. & fine weather Middle & latter part much the same
the Starboard Watch ashore

St Helena Monday September 1st 1856
These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the
S.E. & pleasant weather. Middle & latter part
four men employed in caulking ship. Latter part
much the same. Starboard Watch ashore as usual.

Tuesday Sep 2nd
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from
the S.E. the weather fine. Middle part pleasant
the Starboard watch on shore one crew employed the watch
employed in fanning the breeze on the Starboard side
of the ship. Latter strong gust of wind now & then and light
squalls of rain.

Wednesday Sep 3rd
These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the
S.E. weather warm. Middle part fresh breezes
and light squalls of rain. Starboard watch ashore
watch employed in caulking painting ship &c
Latter part strong breezes & rain.

Thursday Sep 4th
These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the
Southwest & Eastward weather squally. Middle part
windy. Starboard watch ashore. Watch employed
in caulking painting ship &c. Latter part much the
same.

Friday Sep 5th
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from S.E.
weather fine. Middle part pleasant and
employed in caulking & painting ship. Starboard watch
employed in caulking & painting ship. Latter part much the same.

St Helena Saturday September 6th 1856

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the S.E.
weather cloudy. Middle part pleasant all hands
employed in caulking ship & getting off stores in a store
it in the main hatch way at 1 P.M. finished & sailed.
The land watch latter part pleasant.

Sunday Sep 7th
These 24 begins with fine weather & pleasant breezes
from the S.E. Middle & latter part much the same
Starboard Watch ashore.

Monday Sep 8th
These 24 hours begins with fine weather & pleasant
breezes. Middle part pleasant watch employed in paint-
ing ship &c. Starboard watch ashore. Latter part pleasant.

Tuesday Sep 9th
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes
from the S.E. and pleasant weather. Middle part
pleasant watch employed in caulking deck
& painting ship. Starboard watch ashore.
Latter part light breezes & pleasant weather.

Wednesday Sep 10th
These 24 hours begins pleasant weather & light
breeze from the Southwest & Eastward. Middle
part pleasant. Starboard watch ashore. Watch
employed in caulking deck. Latter part wind &
weather much the same.
