

Remarks on board Bark Union of New

Tuesday Sept 20th 1850

These 24 hours begins with strong breeze from S E and squally ship heading S E with all sail set at 9 A M took in fore top gallant sail flying jib and gaff top sail at 6 P M took up the sheet & bare boats Middle part squally latter wind baffling weather much the same

Lat by Obs 20° 25' N
Long by Chron 72° 22' W

Wednesday 21st

These 24 hours begins with strong and baffling breezes from S E off to S E weather squally and rain. Ship heading by the wind to the Eastward with main top gallant sail set at 1 P M took in flying jib & gaff top sail took in and set them again the day as the weather permitted Middle part wind and sail latter part squally Lat by Obs 19° 17' N Long by Chron 72° 26' W

Thursday 22nd

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the S E weather squally ship heading by the wind to the Eastward with all sail set Middle part pleasant watch employed in mending gaff top sail, saw fin back latter part weather heavy Lat by Obs 18° 50' N Long by Chron 72° 08' W

Friday 23rd

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the S E, weather fair ship heading S with all sail set Middle & latter part much the same ends with strong breezes & very foggy Lat by Obs 18° 25' N Long by Chron 71° 33' W

Bedford Alfred C Davis Master 1850

Wednesday Sept 24th

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S E and flower weather fair, ship heading to the Eastward with all sail set Middle part moderate breezes saw fin back Carpenter employed in making studds for the Starboard Boats Davits latter part fresh breezes & foggy Lat by Obs 19° 34' N Long by Chron 69° 16' E

Thursday 25th

These 24 hours begins with strong and baffling breezes from South off to S E weather fair ship heading by the wind to the Eastward Middle part moderate breezes & pleasant saw porpoises latter part much the same Lat by Obs 19° 15' N Long by Chron 69° 21' E

Friday 26th

These 24 hours begins with strong & baffling breezes from South off to S E weather cloudy ship heading by the wind to the Eastward with all sail set Middle part moderate breezes and pleasant saw porpoises latter part wind & weather much the same Lat by Obs 18° 23' N Long by Chron 69° 02' E

Saturday 27th

These 24 hours begins with fresh & baffling breezes from South off S E weather fair ship heading by the wind to the Eastward with all sail set Middle part pleasant saw grampies latter part wind and weather much the same caught 2 porpoises Lat by Obs 18° 24' N Long by Chron 68° 58' E
