

Remarks on board Bark Marion of New

Tuesday Oct 21st 1846

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
weather pleasant ship heading N.W. at daylight
set sail & steered off N.E. Middle part pleasant
saw one fin back, at 1 P.M. steered E.S.E. at sun
down shorten sail & luffed by the wind with the boom
aback heading S.E. Latter part much the same
at 4 P.M. Steered S.W. by the 10, 37
Long by the 10, 18

Wednesday 22nd

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
weather pleasant ship heading aback heading to the
Eastward at daylight set sail & steered off N.E.
Middle part pleasant, at 12 P.M. luffed off S.E.
at sun down shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading
S.E. Latter part much the same, at 4 P.M.
steered aback the head yard, at 4 P.M. Steered
Long by the 10, 36.

Thursday 23rd

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
and fine weather ship heading aback heading E.S.E.
at daylight set sail & steered off N.E. Middle part
pleasant, saw fin backs and in merchant
brig in sight at 3 P.M. steered N.W. at sun
down shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading N.W.
Latter part fresh breeze at 4 P.M. Steered
Long by the 11, 03 E

Friday 24th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
weather pleasant ship heading S.W. at daylight
set sail & steered off E.S.E. Middle part pleasant
saw fin backs and in merchant brig in sight at 3 P.M.
steered N.W. at sun down shorten sail & luffed by
the wind heading N.W. Latter part much the same
at 4 P.M. Steered S.W. by the 10, 38
Long by the 10, 18 E

Saturday Oct 25th 1846

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from South
weather pleasant ship heading to the Eastward
at daylight made sail. Middle part pleasant
at 1 P.M. steered N.E. at sun down shorten sail & luffed
by the wind heading S.E. Latter part light breeze
at 4 P.M. Steered S.W. by the 10, 38 E

Sunday 26th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from South
weather pleasant ship heading to the Eastward
at daylight made sail. Middle part pleasant
at 1 P.M. steered N.E. at sun down shorten sail & luffed
by the wind heading S.E. Latter part light breeze
at 4 P.M. Steered S.W. by the 10, 38 E

Monday 27th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from
S.W. weather pleasant ship heading to the Eastward
at daylight made sail & steered off N.W. Middle part
pleasant, saw fin backs and in merchant brig in sight
at 3 P.M. steered N.W. at sun down shorten sail & luffed
by the wind heading N.W. Latter part light breeze
at 4 P.M. Steered S.W. by the 10, 38 E

Tuesday 28th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from
S.W. weather pleasant ship heading S.E. at daylight
set sail & steered off E.S.E. Middle part pleasant
at 1 P.M. steered N.E. at sun down shorten sail & luffed
by the wind heading S.E. Latter part light breeze
at 4 P.M. Steered S.W. by the 10, 38 E
