and Ship heading E by S. weather cloudy. at 11 1/2 M. of the
an English Ship from Calcutta bound to New York, Ends
No Ob.

Sunday 25th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S & E
weather fair Ship heading E by S. with all sail set and Porpoises
At sundown shorten sail Ship heading E by S. two sails in sight
Middle and Latter part light winds from S & E. At 12 M. S. M. ship
At day light set sail Ship heading East. see Merchant vessel in sight
so Ends

Monday 26th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the South
and pleasant weather Ship heading E by S. and Porpoises
At sundown shorten sail Ship heading E by S. Middle & Latter
part fresh breezes at 12 P. M. ship. At day light set sail
Ship heading E by S. watch employed in painting monkey
bulworks outside. Ends the same

Tuesday 27th

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S & E weather cloudy
At 12 1/2 M. S. M. ship. watch employed in painting at sundown
shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading E by S. with strong breezes.
Middle & Latter much the same at day light set the courses and
were Ship heading E by S. 4 Merchant vessels in sight steering
to the Northward and Westward at 10 P. M. watch employed
in getting out water so ends

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from S & E and pleasant
weather, with a rough sea Ship heading E. with Top sail Courses
gib & Spanker set watch employed in overhauling windmill gear
At sundown took in the courses Ship heading E. Middle part pleasant
At 12 P. M. were Ship. Latter part wind & weather much the same
At 1 P. M. S. M. ship. with Top sail & gib set, two miles in sight
At 2 1/4 P. M. spoke the Bark Ocean of Sandwich Capt. Smith
10 months out ahead

Long by Obs 3.22 W

Thursday 29th

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from S & E with
pleasant weather Ship heading West with Top sail set. at 1 1/2
P. M. S. M. ship. 2 miles in sight at 2 1/2 P. M. watch
employed in getting out Molasses at sundown luffed by the wind
Ship heading E. Middle and Latter part pleasant at 4 P. M.
S. M. ship. ends the same
Lat by Obs 10.43 N
Long by Obs 4.20 W

Friday 30th

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from S & E
and pleasant weather, with a rough sea running Ship heading
N by E. with Top sail set. at 1 P. M. S. M. ship. At sundown
luffed by the wind and luffed the Courses wind from E
Ship heading N by E. one Merchant vessel in sight
Middle part strong breezes from S & E. At day light set
the Fore sail gib & Spanker Ship heading N by E. at 1 1/2 P. M.
more moderate. ends with fresh breezes & pleasant weather
