

Remarks on board of bark Marion of New

Saturday June the 12th 1854

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from SSW
the barometer in the forenoon at 30.2. At 4 P.M. the barometer
& came on board. Whales going or report of them going off S.W.
& the others going E by N very quick. Steered Ship off N.W.
I undown shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading S.E.

Middle & Lutter part ship heading on different tracks
& steering different courses saw Fin Backs. Lat by Obs 3.22
Long by Obs 9.50

Sunday June 13th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the South
weather fair Ship heading by the wind N.S.W. & S.W. by S
Middle & Lutter part ship heading S.W. & S.W. by S
luffed again Ship heading S.W. by N weather overcast

Lat by Obs 3.44

Monday the 14th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the South
weather cloudy & smoky Ship heading S.W. by N at 2 P.M.
wind veered to S.E. Ship heading S.W. by N with all sail set
Middle & Lutter part at 3 P.M. luffed Ship. Ends with
fine pleasant weather, pointing N.W. wind Lat by Obs 4.11
Long by Obs 8.55 E

Tuesday 15th

These 24 hours begins with fine & pleasant breezes from S.W.
Ship heading S.E. at 1 P.M. steered East at sundown
shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading S.E. Middle & Lutter
part pleasant. At day light saw Ship. Lat sail no ends Lat by Obs 4.06
Long by Obs 8.12

Wednesday 16th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from S.S.W.
Ship heading N.E. saw small B.P. & Fin Backs at sundown
steered N.E. & shorten sail Ship heading West. Middle &
Lutter part pleasant at 12 P.M. saw Ship. At day light set
sail Ship heading from S.E. to E.S.E. saw Fin Backs
no ends

Lat by Obs 4.00 E
Long by Obs 8.50 W

Coast of England & Davis Strait

Thursday June the 17th

These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant breezes from
the South Ship heading E.S.E. at sundown shorten sail &
were Ship heading W.N.W. Middle & Lutter part pleasant
at day light set sail & saw Fin Backs. Lat by Obs 4.09
Long by Obs 9.19

Friday the 18th

These 24 hours begins with fine & pleasant breezes from S.W.
Ship heading W.N.W. saw Fin Backs at sundown luffed Ship
heading S.E. Middle & Lutter part fresh breezes at 2 P.M.
luffed Ship heading W.N.W. Ends the same Lat by Obs 4.31
Long by Obs 9.33

Saturday the 19th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from the South
weather fair Ship heading W.N.W. at sundown luffed Ship
& luff in the main course S.W. & E.S. Ship heading E.S.E.
Middle & Lutter part weather cloudy at day light set sail
Ship heading E.S.E. no ends one in sight Lat by Obs 4.30
Long by Obs 9.33

Sunday the 21st

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the South
weather overcast Ship heading E.S.E. at 1 P.M. steered about
2 miles to windward of the small islands the barometer at sundown
luffed Ship & shorten sail Ship heading W.N.W. Middle &
Lutter part light breezes at 12 P.M. saw Ship at day light set sail
Ship heading E.S.E. at 11 P.M. wind veered to S.W. Lat by Obs 4.38
Long by Obs 9.03

Monday 22nd

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.S.W.
weather smoky Lat 1 P.M. steered off E.S.E. at sundown
were Ship shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading West
Middle & Lutter part wind & weather much the same 4.44 P.M.
at day light set sail at 1 P.M. steered N.W. ends 5.05 E

Tuesday 23rd

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from S.W. & S.S.W.
steered N.E. at sundown shorten sail & luffed by the wind heading S.E.
Middle & Lutter part pleasant at day light set sail at 1 P.M.
& steered E. ends 5.05 E
