Wednesday June 25th 1838
These 24 hours begin with fine pleasant breezes from S.W.
Ship steering E by S at sundown was clear & shorted sail
heading W Middle & Latter part pleasant at day light
set sail & steered E by S at 11 A.M. wind moved to South.
so Ends

Thursday 26th

These 24 hours begin with pleasant breezes from the South
& fine weather Ship steering E by S and in Barks at sundown
tacked ship & shorted sail Ship heading S.W.
Middle part calm & light air at 12 P.M. Ship. Latter part
light breeze at daylight set sail at 10 A.M. & Steered E by S
so Ends

Friday 27th

These 24 hours begin with light breezes from the Southward
at 1 P.M. Steered S.W. at 2 P.M. buffed by the wind
heading West a merchant vessel in sight & the wind was
Middle part calm Latter part at daylight a merchant ship
& a top sail schooner in sight Ends with light & puffing breezes

Saturday 28th

These 24 hours begin with light & puffing breezes from the Southward
weather smoky Ship heading to the Southward & Westward
and 1 Top Bark Middle & Latter part light air & very
smoky Ship heading on different tracks Set by Obs 4.15
Long by Chron 9.00

Sunday 29th

These 24 hours begin with light breezes from the Southward
weather smoky Ship heading S.W. at three P.M. tacked
Ship heading E.S.E. at sundown Ship heading S.E. by E
Middle & Latter part moderate breezes weather fair
so Ends

Monday June 29th 1838
These 24 hours begin with light breezes from the Southward fine
Ship heading E.S.E. at sundown shorted sail & tacked Ship
heading S.W. Middle & Latter part moderate breezes fine weather
at daylight set sail Ship heading S.E. at 11 A.M. wind moved to South
lowered at 11 A.M. came on board so Ends

Tuesday 30th

These 24 hours begin with fine pleasant breezes from S.W.
Ship heading S.E. saw small Black B. & saw Hump Backs
at sundown tacked Ship heading W by S Middle &
Latter part fair at 12 P.M. saw Ship at daylight saw Hump
Backs so Ends with

Wednesday July 1st 1838

These 24 hours begin with light breezes from the S
weather smoky Ship heading E.S.E. at 4 P.M. tacked
Ship heading S.W. saw Hump Backs Middle & Latter
part moderate breezes Ship heading on different tracks
so Ends

Set by Obs 4.30
Long by Chron 9.31

Thursday July 2nd

These 24 hours begin with moderate breezes from the
Southward Ship heading S.E. by E Middle & Latter part
fine weather Ship heading to the Southward & East
so Ends

Set by Obs 4.44 S
Long by Chron 9.02 E

Friday July 3rd

These 24 hours begin with moderate winds from S.W.
weather fair Ship heading S.E. saw Hump Backs at sun
down tacked in light sails Ship heading S.E. by S Middle &
Latter part light breezes Ship heading S.E. so Ends
