Wednesday - Dec 24th 1837

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from S.W.
Ship heading S.E. with all sail set at sun down ship heading
South. Middle & Little part pleasant at 12. Lat by Obs 40.00
Long by Obs 11.34

Thursday 25th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from W.W.
Ship heading to S.W. at sun down shorted sail ship
heading S.W. Middle at 12. P.M. ship at 12. Not
tacked ship & steered S.E. Ends with rising
weather and squalls. Lat by Obs 40.30
Long by Obs 10.40

Friday 26th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the W. W.
Ship heading S.E. with passing squalls of rain at sun
down shorted sail Middle part squalls Little
part pleasant with light breezes from the W. W. during
Ship S.E. by S. Lat by Obs 40.20
Long by Obs 10.38 E.

Saturday 27th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
at 12.42 No tacked ship heading W.W. and then
barks at sun down tacked ship & shorted sail ship
heading S by E. Middle & Little part pleasant
wind from the W. at day light wind ship. Lat by Obs 40.2
Ship heading W.W. Long by Obs 10.30

Sunday 28th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from
the W. Ship heading S.W. at sun down tacked
ship & shorted sail ship heading S by W. Middle &
Little part pleasant at day light tacked ship. Lat by Obs 40.2
at 11 A.M. spoke the Brig Commodore of Westport S. 23. Lat 10.18

Monday 29th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from W.W. at sun down
tacked ship & shorted sail ship heading S. Middle & Little part
pleasant at day light steered off S.W. the same
part of way

Tuesday December 1st 1837

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from W.W.
weather pleasant steering ship. A.M. schooner in sight during
to the S.W. at sun down tacked ship & shorted sail ship heading
South. Middle & Little part pleasant at 12. A.M. steered off S.E.
Ends the same. Lat by Obs 40.00
Long by Obs 11.00

Wednesday 2nd

These 24 hours begins with moderate & pleasant breezes from W.W.
at 12.42 No tacked ship. A.M. at sun down shorted sail & luffed by
the wind ship heading S.W. Middle & Little part pleasant
at 12. A.M. steered S.E. Ends the same. Lat by Obs 40.00
Long by Obs 10.40 E

Thursday 3rd

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from W.W.
at 12.42 No tacked ship. E. at sun down shorted sail &
luffed by the wind ship heading S. Middle & Little part
pleasant at 12. A.M. steered S.W. by S. Lat by Obs 40.24
Ends the same, one sail in sight to windward. Long by Obs 9.40

Friday 4th

These 24 hours begins with moderate breeze from S.W. at 12.42
No luffed by the wind heading W.W. and squalls
at sun down tacked ship & shorted sail ship heading S by E
Middle & Little part pleasant at 12. A.M. steered ship S.E.
ends with. Lat by Obs 40.32
Long by Obs 9.31 E

Saturday 5th

These 24 hours begins with moderate & pleasant breezes from W.W.
luffed by the wind ship heading W.W. at sun down tacked
ship & shorted sail ship heading S.E. Middle & Little part
wind & weather much the same at day light tacked ship. Lat by Obs 40.42
heading W.W. Long by Obs 9.01

Sunday 6th

These 24 hours begins with moderate & pleasant breezes from W.W. heading S.W.
at sun down tacked ship & shorted sail ship heading S.E. Middle part pleasant Little
part pleasant at day light with pleasant weather. Lat by Obs 40.00
