

Remarks on board of Dash Marion of Mass

Sunday Jan^y 31st 1835

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the South wind weather smoky Ship heading to the South & Westward at 2 P.M. moderate touched Ship heading S.E. Middle part light baffling winds from the S.W. Ship heading from S.W. to S.E. Latter part moderate breezes from S.W. heading S.E. Lat by Obs 3.33 Long by Obs 7.45

Monday February 1st

These 24 hours begins with moderate winds from S.W. Ship heading S.E. weather pleasant said Breeze Middle part light air Latter part pleasant breezes from S.W. Ship heading S.E. Lat by Obs 3.41 Long by Obs 8.27 E

Tuesday February 2nd

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the W. Ship heading S.W. said Breeze Middle part moderate & baffling breezes from the westward Ship heading from S.W. off to S.E. Latter part at 10 A.M. touched Ship heading S.W. Lat by Obs 3.39 Long by Obs 8.48 E

Wednesday 3rd

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the Southward weather pleasant at 1 P.M. touched Ship heading S.E. by S Middle & Latter part fresh breezes from S.W. Ship heading S.E. so Ends Lat by Obs 4.24 Long by Obs 9.36 E

Thursday 4th

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S.W. Ship heading S.E. weather fine at sundown touched Ship & shortened sail heading West by S Middle & Latter part moderate at day light were Ship heading to the Westward Lat by Obs 4.44 Long by Obs 10.40

Friday 5th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from S.W. Ship heading West at 4 P.M. touched Ship & shortened sail heading S.W. Middle & Latter part light air intermixed with calms Lat by Obs 5.27 Long by Obs 11.50

Saturday February 6th 1835

These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant breezes from the Southward & Westward Ship heading to the S.E. Middle & Latter part moderate breezes Ship heading S.E. Lat by Obs 4.32 Long by Obs 12.10 E

Sunday 7th

These 24 hours begins fresh breezes from the S.W. weather fair Ship heading S.E. Middle part fresh breezes from S.W. Ship heading S.E. Latter part light breezes at day light and a school of Whales to windward at 1 P.M. to beached from them proved to be Fin Back at 9.42 came on board. Ends Ship heading S.E. Lat by Obs 5.11 Long by Obs 11.12 E

Monday 8th

These 24 hours begins with light & baffling breezes from the Southward & Westward at 12.12 the touched Ship heading to the Westward at 1 P.M. wind veered to the Ship heading S.W. Fin Backs and plenty of small Fish visible Middle part strong breezes from the S.W. & equally & veering steering S.W. Latter part strong winds from the S.W. weather directly Ends quite fair Lat by Obs 5.26 Long by Obs 11.42 E

Tuesday 9th

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from S.W. at 12.42 the touched S.E. at sundown shortened sail & buffed by the wind heading S.W. Middle part light breezes from the S.E. Eastward Ship heading to the S.W. Latter part light air & calms Ends the same Lat by Obs 5.47 Long by Obs 11.02 E

Wednesday 10th

These 24 hours begins with light air from the S.E. steering S.W. at sundown shortened sail Ship heading by the wind to the S. wind very light & baffling Middle part calms Latter part light breezes from the S.W. Ship heading S.W. but not employed in painting. Ends the same Lat by Obs 6.25 Long by Obs 12.10 E
