Wednesday February 23<sup>rd</sup> 1838  
These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the S.E.  
Stearing W by N. Middle & Latter part moderate breezes  
Stearing W by N. at 4 1/2 A.M. saw the island of St. Helena  
one point of the lee bow about 60 miles dist. Steered off fair

Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant breezes from  
the S.E. Ship Stearing off for the island at 9 A.M.  
come to an anchor in the Rhoadstead of James town  
in 21 fathoms of water 45 fathoms of dubin. in company with  
a number the vessel Middle part pleasant Latter part  
all hands employed in unloading ship inside & out

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E.  
Middle & Latter part fresh breezes. Starboard watch  
on liberty 20 ends

Friday 26<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S.E.  
weather pleasant Starboard watch on liberty Middle  
& Latter part pleasant Starboard watch on liberty

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.E.  
weather pleasant Starboard watch on liberty Middle  
part much the same Latter part Starboard watch on liberty  
20 ends

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from S.E. Starboard  
watch on liberty Middle part pleasant Latter part much  
the same Starboard watch on liberty

Monday March 1<sup>st</sup> 1838  
These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E.  
Starboard watch on liberty arrived one American merchantman  
and the mail steamer Middle weather much the same  
Latter part 2 boats crew ashore getting down Provisions tea wine  
has the Stipton 21 months out Valparaiso and the Bark  
Clear bound for home fought a pipe of bread from her

Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather 2 boats  
crew getting off provisions at 5 P.M. took them on board  
Middle & Latter part all hands employed in stowing  
provisions ends the same

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with fresh & heavy breezes from the S.E.  
arrived here the Bark Minnetonka 21 months out 630 sp.  
Middle part rain Latter part drier Starboard watch  
on liberty

Thursday 4<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S.E. weather  
fair Starboard watch on liberty Middle & Latter part  
breezes and pleasant

Friday 5<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.E.  
watch employed in getting bread from the Minnetonka <sup>much better</sup>  
Starboard watch on liberty Middle & Latter part pleasant  
Starboard watch employed in getting of provisions from the  
Bark Ann of St. James

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.E.  
weather pleasant Starboard watch on liberty Middle  
& Latter part pleasant 20 ends

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.E.  
watch on liberty Middle & Latter part pleasant  
ends with the same weather much the same
