

Remarks on Board of Bark Mission of New

Saturday April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1858

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the Westward steering Ship. air E by N for little Fish Bar at sundown calm some at anchor in the mouth of bay 22 fathoms with the Bark Keeha Capt. Grinnell & mounted out about Middle & Latter part pleasant

Sunday 4<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather & light breeze Middle & Latter part much the same

Monday 5<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the Southward Middle & Latter part much the same as first part at 12 M the bark Keeha sailed

Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from S W Middle & Latter part light breezes

Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with light air from the S W Middle part the same Latter part pleasant breezes ends the same getting off fishhook

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the S W at 2 P M weighed anchor and stood out to sea steering N W with a fresh breeze Middle part from 10 to 4 light breezes Latter part steering W N W at 12 M light breezes from the N. at 10 A M fresh breezes from S W

Friday 9<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from S W weather smoky steering Ship W N W Middle & Latter part moderate breezes from the Southward steering Ship. W N W ends the same said Shark Fish

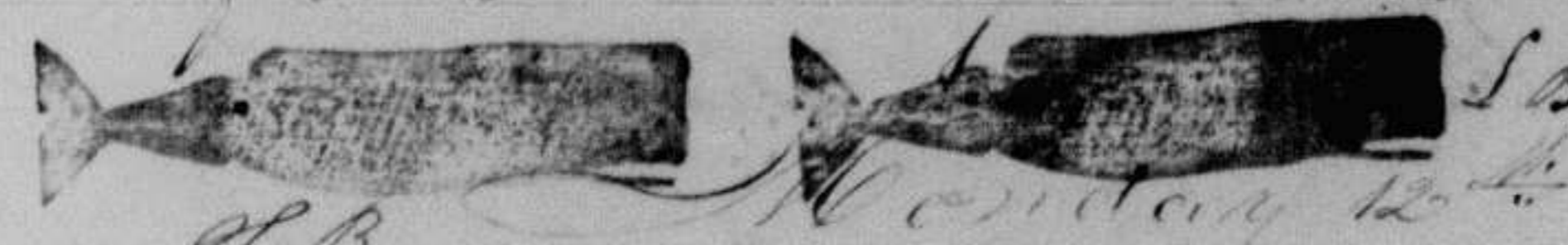

Saturday April 10<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from S W steering W N W Middle & Latter part moderate breezes from N. S ends the same  
Set by Obs 15.00 S  
Long by Obs 57 E

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the Southward steering W N W weather smoky at sundown some Porpoises one shot in sight Middle part from 11 P M to dark light air by the wind under easy sail Latter part S W & Steered N W with fresh breezes & rough sea 20 miles  
Set by Obs 14.45 S  
Long by Obs 57.10 E



These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from S W at 1 P M Steered N E at 1 1/2 P M saw 3 or 4 Whales lowered & caught 3 Middle part employed in cutting them at inside Latter part employed in cutting in running before the wind hauled in 100 lbs ends the same

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with strong S W winds & angled steering Ship N E under Fore Top sail all hands employed in cutting at 4 P M one of the Whales parted parted the fluke rope at 6 P M cut him along side again Middle part heading on the Eastern track watches employed in cutting blubber Latter part cut in the other Whale ends with all hands employed in drawing away heads

Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with moderate S winds at 4 P M Steered Ship heading W N W all hands employed in cutting Middle part wind light Latter part the same with all sail set  
Set by Obs 14.00 S  
Long by Obs 6.13 E

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with light & pleasant winds from the S W steering Ship W N W Middle & Latter part moderate breezes from the Southward steering Ship. W N W ends the same said Shark Fish
