Sunday Mar 2th 1838

These 24 hours begins with fine land pleasant breezes from the N. at 1 P.M. Sore Ship heading W.S.W. and Pin Backs and small black fish. at sundown shorten sail, heading W.S.W. Middle and Litter part fine weather at daylight started S.W. by Ob 6.57
N.W. by N. saw Porpoises Long by Obs 10.45

Monday 10th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the S. Steering ship N.W. by N. at sundown shorten sail and luffed by the wind heading W.S.W. Middle and Litter part pleasant at daylight started S.W. by N. ends the same. Lat by Obs 6.32
Long by Obs 10.50 E

Tuesday 11th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from the S.W. at 12 1/2 M. started N.E. at sundown shorten sail and luffed by the wind heading S.E. Middle and Litter part pleasant at daylight started N.W. by N. ends the same. Lat by Obs 6.40

Wednesday 12th

These 24 hours begins with light and pleasant breezes from the S.W. at 1 P.M. started N.E. by N. at sundown shorten sail and luffed by the wind heading S.E. Middle and Litter part pleasant at daylight started N.E. saw Porpoises so ends with. Lat by Obs

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S.W. at 1 P.M. started W.N.W. struck into black water saw plenty of small fish at sundown luffed ship and at daylight heading S.E. Middle and Litter part pleasant at daylight started S.W. heading on different luffs. Lat by Obs 6.58

These 24 hours begins with light airs from the Southward ship heading on different luffs at sundown calm Middle and Litter part light breezes from the S.W. ship heading to the S.E. Lat by Obs 6.20

Sunday 16th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from S.W. ship heading to the S.E. at sundown luffed ship and shorten sail heading W. Middle and Litter part pleasant ship heading to the Eastward. Lat by Obs 6.41
Long by Obs 10.20

Monday 17th

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from the Westward ship heading S.E. at sundown luffed ship and shorten sail heading W.N.W. Middle and Litter part calm water employed in cleaning chains so ends. Lat by Obs 6.31
Long by Obs 10.35 E

Tuesday 18th

These 24 hours begins with a calm water employed in cleaning and painting chains Middle and Litter part light and pleasant breezes from S.W. at 2 P.M. started W.N.W. so ends. Lat by Obs

Wednesday 19th

These 24 hours begins with pleasant breezes from S.W. at 2 P.M. started N. saw Killers at sundown shorten sail and luffed by the wind heading W.N.W. Middle and Litter part light breezes. Lat by Obs

Thursday 20th

These 24 hours begins with light airs and calms steering S.E. Middle part light breezes from S and W heading to the S.E. Litter part pleasant at 4 P.M. started S.E. so ends. Lat by Obs

Friday 21st

These 24 hours begins with light airs intermittent with calms steering N.E. at sundown luffed by the wind heading S.E. Middle and Litter part pleasant at daylight started S.E. ends the same saw 12 Porpoises compass. Lat by Obs 6.58
