

Remarks on board of Bark Marion of New Bedford

Tuesday June 2<sup>nd</sup> 1835

These 24 hours begins with strong South winds & rugged ship heading to the Eastward with employment in setting 10 S. B. hooks & rigging 1000 Porpoises. Kump & a Lin back Middle part 12 P.M. were ship. Latter part fresh breezes at 8 1/2 A.M. passed the windward of a bark supposed to be the Liverpool cutting, at 12 at the light sail. Set by Obs 18.45

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup>

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from the Southward ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. put out a mid boat on the starboard expanse at our down took in the light sail and Porpoises Middle & Latter part strong breezes at 8 A.M. were ship. at 8 A.M. doubled reefed the topsails & pulled the courses all hands employed in stowing down oil. Set by Obs 19.01 in the fore hatch at 11 1/2 finished

Thursday July 1<sup>st</sup>

These 24 hours begins with strong S. winds ship heading to the Eastward, was Porpoises Middle part the same latter part fresh breezes at day light were ship. saw 2 Kump back. Set by Obs 19.07

Friday July 2<sup>nd</sup>

These 24 hours begins with fresh winds ship heading N. E. at 2 P.M. set whale topsails, it was down for at the course saw a Lin back & saw Porpoises Middle part the same at day light were ship heading N. E. at the fore sail at 7 A.M. saw 30 barrels for sperm. Whales close to the ship caught 2 Ends quite moderate winds & smooth sea

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup>

These 24 hours begins with quite moderate S winds & smooth sea at 2 P.M. set the Whales along side at 4 P.M. commenced cutting Middle part at 8 P.M. at one Whale in closed away head & c. Latter part at 11 A.M. finished cutting in the other Whale Ends with fresh breezes ship heading E. Set by Obs 19.51

Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from the Southward ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. set 10 S. B. hooks & rigging 1000 Porpoises & a Lin back Middle part 12 P.M. were ship. Latter part fresh breezes at 8 1/2 A.M. passed the windward of a bark supposed to be the Liverpool cutting, at 12 at the light sail. Set by Obs 18.45

Alfred C. Davis New Bedford 1835

Monday July 8<sup>th</sup> 1835

These 24 hours begins with fresh winds from the S. boat off wharves Whales caught 2 at 8 P.M. took one along side Middle part at 11 1/2 commenced boiling & c. at 8 P.M. took the other Whale along side Latter part all hands employed in cutting in & boiling Ends with strong breezes

Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with strong winds & rugged ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. put out a mid boat on the starboard expanse at our down took in the light sail and Porpoises Middle & Latter part strong breezes at 8 A.M. were ship. at 8 A.M. doubled reefed the topsails & pulled the courses all hands employed in stowing down oil. Set by Obs 19.01 in the fore hatch at 11 1/2 finished

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with strong S winds & rugged ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. put out a mid boat on the starboard expanse at our down took in the light sail and Porpoises Middle & Latter part strong breezes at 8 A.M. were ship. at 8 A.M. doubled reefed the topsails & pulled the courses all hands employed in stowing down oil. Set by Obs 19.01 in the fore hatch at 11 1/2 finished

Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with strong S winds & rugged ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. put out a mid boat on the starboard expanse at our down took in the light sail and Porpoises Middle & Latter part strong breezes at 8 A.M. were ship. at 8 A.M. doubled reefed the topsails & pulled the courses all hands employed in stowing down oil. Set by Obs 19.01 in the fore hatch at 11 1/2 finished

Friday 12<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with more moderate weather & smooth sea all hands employed in boiling ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. put out a mid boat on the starboard expanse at our down took in the light sail and Porpoises Middle & Latter part strong breezes at 8 A.M. were ship. at 8 A.M. doubled reefed the topsails & pulled the courses all hands employed in stowing down oil. Set by Obs 19.01 in the fore hatch at 11 1/2 finished

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours begins with moderate winds ship heading N. E. at 4 P.M. put out a mid boat on the starboard expanse at our down took in the light sail and Porpoises Middle & Latter part strong breezes at 8 A.M. were ship. at 8 A.M. doubled reefed the topsails & pulled the courses all hands employed in stowing down oil. Set by Obs 19.01 in the fore hatch at 11 1/2 finished
