Remarks Monday July 19th 1841
Comences with fresh gales from NW cloudy
middle thick and squally with some
spattering of rain run to the N & S. ~~Still~~
bore too on the western bank of S. All took
in fore top. sail bore too See boats on
the upper river last part strong
gale thick and stormy
Lat 47-26 N Long 28-48 W

Remarks Tuesday July 20th 1841
Comences strong breezes from NW
hauling more to North till broke
a way last part moderate made
sail to ~~W~~ Ward saw a Brig running
NW last part moderate and squally
Obs in Lat 47-24 N Long 28-09 W Cr.

Wednesday July 21st 1841
Commenced with moderate breeze from
NW had sea headed on ear and NEward
at 8 PM bore two head to North at 4 AM wore
Ship made all sail to SW last part
fair weather glass rising but no Whales
but by 11 by 46-50 N. and Dr. by 15 by 28-33 W.

Thursday July 22nd 1841
Commences with light Wind from West. A few
thick fogs 4 P.M. hauled to NW clear &
the rest of the day headed to the South
saw Black fish at 3 P.M. commenced got fast with
Wair boat dragged saw number vessels
lost by Obs 46-03 W. fog 28-00 W. C.

Ther 24 hours light air and calms
with fair weather headed to N. W. Wind
N. W.

Lat 46-06 N Long 129-21.5 W G.

Saturday July 24th 1841
Commences with light breezes and fair
weather middle some squally latter
fresh winds NW to WNW backed
to the west the next post 24 hours
saw a large Gray porpoise swim
wth shoveling sail and were off before
the wind Lat 46.04 Long 29.00 Br

Sunday July 25th 1841
 There 24 hours moderate breeze from
 the SW fair weather at 1 o'clk went ship
 to the South in W. Gale
 Sat 45-46 N Long 28-50 W Lat 61-

Monday July 26th 1841
There 24 hours moderate breeze from
SW to WNW fair weather seen
several sail have been heading SW
Wind set by 10 44-46 N by 28-32 W by

Tuesday July 27th 1841
There 24 hours moderate breeze from
the North and N.E. with Calms fair
weather - have seen several mist
but by Obs 44-18 & by 29-23 W. Co.
