

Bark Mars from N Bedford

Wednesday July 28th 1841
these 24 hours moderate breezes
and fair weather lay by at night
ran to the NW a days Wind NE
Lat 44-11 N Long 30-31 W by Co

Thursday July 29th 1841
These 24 hours fresh breezes from the
East and fair weather seen till
Pm 3 o'clock
Lat 42-39 N Long 31-10 W Co

Friday July 30th 1841
Commences with moderate breezes and
fair weather mistle some squalls
latter part fair seen killer
fair Backs &c
Lat 41-18 N Long 31-18 W Co

Saturday July 31st 1841
These 24 hours fresh and variable
Winds from the NE & with some
squalls at 6 AM saw the Island
of Com bearing SW by S 30 miles
Lat 41-12 N Long 31-18 W with
Flora in sight
Lat 41-12 - Chronometer about 26 miles
to the East

towards Pacific Ocean A Bronnell ^{Brook}

Sunday August 1st 1841
These 24 hours westerly Winds and
some squalls ran in near the passage
between Flores and Coma bore to
dark headed to North Wind NE
this morning saw 5 seal all Whalers
ran off to SW the Chronometer 29 miles
to the West Obs in 39-15 N Flores 15 miles

Monday August 2nd 1841
Commences with fresh breezes from the NE
mistle and latter part moderate ran off
to the west during the day saw a brig
and 2 other sail suppose them to be Whalers
Obs in Lat 39-16 Long 32-41 West

Tuesday August 3rd 1841
Commences with moderate breezes from the
NE latter part from SW have headed
back to the Eward and shall go in and
and leave this ground and look for better
a sail a chaseing us a steer but we have
him Lat 38-59 Long 32-36 West Co

Wednesday August 4th 1841
these 24 hours fresh breezes from the Wward
fair weather ran off during the night under
short sail at 7 AM saw Flores bearing
North of us saw several sail steering off
Lat by Obs 38-31 N Long 30-16 West Co
