Wednesday Sept 8th 1841

These 24 hours baffling and unsteady winds has been about dead South tacked a great number of time & every cast of the Wind it has been a dead heat for us had run Lat $22^{\circ}03'30''$ N Long $22^{\circ}10'W$ Ebb

Thursday Sept 9th 1841

These 24 hours strong breezes from South and overcast weather high sea running headed to the East at 10 AM tacked to West continued on the Western tack with top gallant sails in

Lat by Obs $2-04$ N Long $22-19$ W Ebb

Friday Sept 10th 1841

These 24 hours strong breezes from the South set the all top gallant sails several times but carried but a short time have headed up nearly WNW with a boat one Point Westerly Variation Wind about South Lat Obs $2-17$ N Long $23-19$ W Ebb

Saturday Sept 11th 1841

These 24 hours begins with strong breezes & a bit of fine top Gal Gaff top sail middle and last part moderate breezes fine weather the Wind has inclined to East of South

Sunday June Sept 12th 1841

These 24 hours fine breezes and clear weather close haul by the Wind headed to SW Wind NE

Lat $00-23$ South Long $26-55$ W Ebb

Monday Sept 13th 1841

These 24 hours moderate breezes from S by E to NE fair weather sea smooth Lat $1-38$ S Long $28-41$ W Ebb Current to the WNW

Tuesday Sept 14th 1841

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from S by E to South middle do latter part brisk breeze from NE Lat fine clear weather sea smooth Lat Obs $2-57$ S Long $29-58$ W Ebb

Wednesday Sept 15th 1841

These 24 hours strong breezes and unsteady carried all top Gal the 24 hours gages sharp by the Wind with a few squalls Lat $4-42$ S Long $31-00$ W Ebb Wind SE to S by E

Thursday Sept 16th 1841

Commences with moderate breezes fair weather middle and last part squally but sea latter part 24 hours Wind SE and Easterly

Lat $6-13$ S Long $34-42$ West Ebb
