

Bark Mars from N Bedford

Tuesday Oct 5th 1841

There 24 hours very light baffling air
and variable with Calm clear weather
Lat 24-20 S Long 23-50 W Obs

Wednesday Oct 6th 1841

There 24 light air and variable with
Calm swell from South clear weather
Lat 24-40 S Long 23-31 W

Thursday Oct 7th 1841

Comences with light breezes from the North
steering sails all set at 10 P.M. but her
steering way Calm the next 24 hours
Lat 25-01 S Long 23-19 W Obs

Friday Oct 8th 1841

There 24 hours light air and cloudy
heavy swell from the South Wind has
been from N.E. to S.W. No Obs
Lat Dr 25-46 S Long 23-09 W

Saturday Oct 9th 1841

Comences with light baffling air from the
North fair weather. At 4 P.M. squally thick
misting continued to the latter part of the night
at 1 P.M. light winds from N.W. fair weather
heavy long swell from the South has knocked
the bark through the beam at top Gallant
sails and the rest will not have much
better if it continues

Lat by Obs 25-23 S Long 21-50 W Obs

Towards Pacific Ocean & Brunell

Sunday Oct 10th 1841

Comences with light baffling winds from
the North heavy swell from the South
mistle and latter part stormy with
moderate breezes from N.E. heavy
ground swell against us
Lat Dr 27-44 S Long 20-57

Monday Oct 11th 1841

There 24 hours moderate and unsteady
breezes from N.E. not so much head sea
weather thick and stormy no Obs
Lat Dr 29-30 S Long Dr 19-52 West

Tuesday Oct 12th 1841

There 24 hours moderate and unsteady
breezes and thick weather with moderate
rain

Obs in Lat 30-45 S Long 18-41 Dr

Wednesday Oct 13th 1841

Comences with moderate breezes thick
with showers Wind North backing
at 8 P.M. Calm but took light breeze shortly
from East took in steering sails trimmed by
the Wind last part moderate breezes thick
no Obs Lat Dr 31-40 S Long Dr 17-38 West

Thursday Oct 14th 1841

There 24 hours moderate and unsteady Wind
thick and rainy for the most part steering
sails set Wind N.E. North and N.W.
Lat by Obs 32-30 S Long Dr 15-41 West
