Commences ^{fair} with fine breezes from North cloudy
Bar on 30 falling to 29.07 to 29.08
took in fore top steering sail at 8 double reefed
at 10 fore reefed top sail reefed fore sail
Wind NW at 11 AM blew a heavy gale kept
before the Wind heavy rain at 8 hauled to
WNW cleared off last part strong breezes
fair weather Wind NW
Lat 37-04 S Long 48-34 E Obs

Wednesday Nov 3rd 1841
begins with moderate breezes from NW high
sea from West middle light and hupling
last part at 11 fair weather 24 hours
at Main rigging Bar on 29.07 to 10
Lat Obs 36-58 S Long 47-36 E Obs

Thursday Nov 4th 1841
These 24 hours variable Winds and weather
Commences fair at 8 AM equally with light
double reefed Wind at NW hauled at 11 then
West fore reefed at 11 at 4 AM made sail thick
raining at 7 at 11 top gut at 9 shifted to
South double reefed last part strong breezes
cloudy No Obs Lat Dr 36-54 S Long 46-54 E Obs

Friday Nov 5th 1841
Commences thick weather Wind at SE middle
middle thinner light ning heavy rain
latter part a heavy rain storm Wind
went further to East
Lat Dr 36-10 S Long 48-00 E Obs

Saturday Nov 6th 1841
Commences with strong gales from SE heavy
rain at 6 AM cleared off Bar rose from 29.08
to 30 has been so the rest 24 hours middle and
last part light air and hupling with
calms and swell from SE
Lat 35-16 S Long 48-42 E Obs

Sunday Nov 7th 1841
Commences with light hupling Wind from NW
eastern swell middle and last part fine breezes
from NW clear weather all sail set
Lat Obs 35-48 S Long 51-24 E Obs

Monday Nov 8th 1841
These 24 hours fine breezes from NW to North
fair weather steering sails set soon right
Whole but to good a breeze to stop further
Lat 35-57 S Long Obs 54-57 E Obs

Tuesday Nov 9th 1841
Commences with fine breezes fair weather Wind
at NW middle and latter part fresh gales
with thick fog a haze a part of the time
Wind so the Bar began to fall at 1 PM but set up
Lat Obs 35-26 S Long 58-41 E Obs

Wednesday Nov 10th 1841
These 24 hours fine part hupling middle
so equally with calms last part a steady breeze
at NW clear weather all sail set at 12 AM spoke
the Ship Bowditch of Providence & Leigh Whaler
Lat 35-23 S Long 61-00 E Obs
