

Bark Mars from N Bedford

Sunday Nov 28th 1841

There 24 hours fine breeze and fair weather  
steered off 8 AM by compass under short sail  
during the night Bar above 30  
Lat 34-22 N Long 104-54 E Eros

Monday Nov 29th 1841

Commenced with moderate breezes from  
NW fair weather latter strong breezes  
from WNW ran under easy sail during  
the night Bar on 29-09  
Lat 34-47 N Long 109-50 E Eros

Tuesday Nov 30th 1841

Commenced with strong breezes middle and  
latter part blowing heavy snow too at  
4 PM headed to NW at day light  
kept off Lat under double reef. Wind at  
1 PM NW but sea boats all in upper  
waves Bar rising at 12 AM near 30  
Lat 34-18 N Long 109-54 E Eros

Wednesday N Dec 1st 1841

Commenced with strong gale at NW at 6 AM  
have too headed to West Ward at day light  
more ship to leeward latter part light  
Winds and Calms high sea large shoals  
black fish Bar rising up to 30-04  
Lat 33-56 N Long 110-29 E Eros

Towards Pacific Ocean A Brownells boat

Thursday December 2nd 1841

Commenced with light Winds from NNW high  
small clear middle Calm latter part  
moderate breeze from ESE Bar on 30-04  
Lat 33-55 N Long 110-51 E Eros

Friday Dec 3rd 1841

Commenced with light breezes from NW  
middle do at 1 PM latter strong breeze  
equally at day light made sail & ran to  
ESE but observed the Bar-ter fell during  
the night from 30-04 to 29-02 at 8 AM covered  
by the wind to NW under double reef  
at 11 AM took up her boats two under  
close reef all the sail spencers stay sail  
Lat Dec 34-19 N Long 112-27 E

Saturday Dec 4th 1841

Commenced with strong gales from NW squally  
middle do but moderate breeze began to rise  
at 8 PM at 2 PM more ship too ran a  
Ship to South of us at day light have  
went in the rest of the day headed to NW  
to run a bark to E Ward steering to NW  
Lat part light winds and bad sea  
Lat Dec 34-02 N Long 111-28 E Eros

Sunday Dec 5th 1841

There 24 hours high huffing Winds from  
the West Ward high sea some part Calm  
cloudy at 5 PM spoke the Ship John Adams  
& Bedford one high Wale saw a bark steering  
Lat Dec 33-58 Long 111-43 Eros
