

Bark Mars from N Bedford

Friday Dec 31st 1841

There 24 hours moderate breezes from N'W sea smooth most part foggy

Bar 29.87 to 82

Lat 42-04 S Long 127-58 E Circ

Saturday January 1st 1842

Commences with fresh breezes and cloudy steering sails set at 8 bell took in light sails freshens Bar falling 2 AM Double reefed fore top sail at 8 AM took in Main sail last part strong gales Wind has been from NW to North the Bar has gone down to 29.04 and falling yet

Lat Obs 43-08 S Long Dr 131-41 E Circ

Sunday Jan 2nd 1842

Commences with strong gales and heavy squalls rain took in Whist boat close reef Main top sail reefed fore sail took in fore top sail sent down fore top gal yard Wind NW to N'W at 3 bell cleared up Wind died hauled more to West Bar falling hauled out WNW light & strong gales squally had sea wind back NW Bar down to 29.06 continues squally 12 AM Bar on 29.01 at 2 AM began to rise cleared of hauled out to West last part at 12 AM Bar 29.4

Lat Obs 44-08 S Long 135-12 E Circ

Monday Jan 3rd 1842 - Commences fresh gales Wind NW at 8 bell took in double reefs took in Main 10 close reefed top sail & reefed fore sail blowing heavy strong 2 AM bare top Wind North Bar on 29.01 at 6 AM more shifted hauled NW run again last part unsteady squally Bar down to 29.01 yet

Lat Obs 44-37 S Long 138-16 E Circ

Towards Pacific Ocean A Brownell Boat

Tuesday Jan 4th 1842

There 24 hours very unsteady winds and squally blowing from WSW to North Bar has been down to 29.01 and has been stationary at that some part ^{time} the Wind very strong at 11 AM

Lat 44-57 S Long 141-23 E Circ

Wednesday Jan 5th 1842

There 24 hours begins squally Wind NW light at 2 bell Calm downed down the sails stored before the swell Bar down 29.01 at 6 bell took a breeze from WNW at 8 Bar began to rise squally the rest of the day reefed down took in and turned out at occasion required and with steady breezes from WNW Bar on 29.04

Lat Obs 45-00 S Long 144-18 E Circ

Thursday Jan 6th 1842

Commences with fresh and unsteady breezes from WNW to West middle and latter part light and blowing with a heavy swell from WNW to West Wind NW to WNW Bar rose gradually the 24 hour 12 AM up 29.08

Lat Obs ~~44-55~~ 44-57 S Long 146-55 E Circ

Friday Jan 7th 1842

Commences with unsteady breezes from the West middle thick and some part of the time foggy last part light breezes from WNW Bar risen 29.08

Lat Obs 44-14 S Long 149-55 E Circ

Sat Jan 8th 1842

There 24 hours begins light air from NW middle and last part light air and Calm Bar on 29.10 2

Lat Obs 43-55 S Long 150-36 E Circ
