Wednesday Jan 19th 1842
Comences with fresh breezes from South
headed to West - middle Calm 2nd 10 AM
took ~~a~~ a moderate breeze from NW
high swell the 24th ^{from} from SW strong easterly
current Bar nearly set 29.07 to 30
Lat 36-25 S Long 161-31 E Cro

Thursday Jan 20th 1842
Comences with high winds from NW high
swell from NW middle thick squally last
part strong breezes from SW at 5 AM
Wind shift to NW Bar falling until 6 AM set 29.06
Lat 36-22 S Long 160-53 E Cro

Friday Jan 21st 1842
Comences with strong breezes from the
South headed to West middle and
last part Calm strong current to East
Bar from 29.06 rose to 29.8 and then 9 cloudy
Lat 35-52 S Long 160-54

Sat Jan 22nd 1842
Comences with Calm middle at 9 AM
took a moderate breeze from NE last
the rest of the day steered WNW the water
is full of jelly substance and drops like tallow
Bar from 29.9 to 30.02
Lat 35-38 S Long 160-42 E Cro

Pacific Ocean Whaling A Bowness Bark

Sunday Jan 23th 1842
Comences with light breezes from East cloudy
middle heavy thunders storm lashing and wind
Winds at 8 AM wind shifted to South and NE
saw a sail to SW Bar from 29.07 to 29.09
Lat 35-08 S Long 160-00 E Cro

Monday Jan 24th 1842
Comences with strong breezes from NE &
ran WNW at 2 AM bore too headed to SW and
middle squally and unsteady Wind last part
moderate with light showers 8 to 11
Bar on 29.09 to 29.30-01
Lat 34-13 S Long 158-50 E Cro

Tuesday Jan 25th 1842
These 24 hours light and buffing Wind
and some squalls Wind from East to SE
saw a sail to SW steered off WNW and NE
bore too headed to SW during night steered by
Wind NE strong current to SW Bar 30
Lat 33-19 S Long 159-04 E Cro

Wednesday Jan 26th 1842
these 24 hours light breezes from NE to SE
clear weather at day light saw Bull's Pyramid
and Ford's Home Island bearing NW by NE by compass
taken at 6 AM lashed to NE headed to NE the
rest of day current to NE Lat 32-22 S
Long 159-41 Cro at 11 AM Bar on 30
