

Bunker Mass from N Bedford in

Thursday Feb 3rd 1842

There 24 hours light baffling airs
with squalls and showers get the
hatches stowed at 5 PM the Whales
stowed down 49 bls 25 gal about a barrel
a half left Bar on about 30
Lat 34-13 S Long 162-23 E Cms

Friday Feb 4th 1842

Comences with moderate breezes and fair
weather Middle & last part fresh breezes
from N under double reefs Wind SE
headed to N Wind Bar on 30- to 30-01
Lat Obs 33-30 S Long 163-41 E Cms

Saturday Feb 5th 1842

There 24 hours strong gales from NE
fair weather - saw Sperme Whale a few
minutes before 12 o'clock down boats but
could not get near them very
rugged Bar on 30-11
Lat Br 33-18 S Long 165-26 E Cms

Sunday Feb 6th 1842

Comences strong gales from NE droyed the
Whales as they kept along to East lowered
twice could not get near them sea bad
headed to East all night tucked at 6 AM
to West at 7 AM saw Whales to West
lowered got 2 one Waist one barboard
got one a long side at 11 not to see for other
Bar 30-11 2/2
Lat Obs 33-07 S Long 166-11 E Cms

Pacific Ocean Whaling + Journal Book

Monday Feb 7th 1842

Comences with moderate breezes from NE
fine weather middle and last part light airs
and variable with Calms at 12 PM got both
Whales a long side cut in one got the head
down at 9 PM and decks cleared off today
light comences on the other got all on Deck
at 12 o'clock Bar on 30-02
Lat 32-34 S Long 165-50 E Cms

Tuesday Feb 8th 1842

Comences with light Winds fair weather
middle baffling with Calms last part
a moderate breeze from NE at 1 PM comen
boiling on body at 8 AM saw Whales to
the West of us lowered 2 boats kept the
try works going got on with the barboard
had run bad but killed
him got him a long side
at 12 o'clock Bar on 30-02
Lat Obs 32-14 S Long about 165-30 S

Wednesday Feb 9th 1842

There 24 hours moderate breezes from
NE to ~~East~~ fair North and fair weather
boiling the 24 hours at 3 PM hooked
down to the last Whale cut off the
head bone in the jaw lashed the piece
to the Deck finished boiling body
at 9 AM filled from Cooler 21 bls
Bar from 30-02 to 30-01
Lat Obs 32-23 S Long 165-17 E Cms
