

Bark Mars from N Bedford

Thursday Feb 10th 1842

There 24 hours light winds from NW to North fine weather Boiling the 24 hours out of the junkies we had on deck and hove in the body of the Whale we had a long side and let the head log all night at 8 AM got all in and got to boiling on the last head at 12 o'clock scalded to the Wit 24 hours Bar 30-01 at 2
Lat 32-28 S Long 165-17 E Eve

Friday Feb 11th 1842

There 24 hours light baffling airs from NW to NE with Calm sea smooth finished boiling our last Whale at 8 AM at 4 AM broke out and began to storm the first Whales on starboard side no Obs and no time to attend to it
Bar on 30-02

Saturday Feb 12th 1842

There 24 hours light breezes from NW to NE fair weather at day light kept off NW by 1 have been stowing down Oil the 24 hours finished at 11 AM
Lat Obs 33-02 S Long 164-49 E Eve

Sunday Feb 13th 1842

There 24 hours light breezes from the North and East with Calm clear weather
Bar on 30-02 to 3
Lat 33-41 S Long 164-21 E Eve

Monday Feb 14th 1842

There 24 hours some light airs from NE but the most part Calm - this morning the Steward began a row with Mr. Thompson I went up to shut him but got every kind of insolence from him threatening to maim and cripple the Mate seized him in riggering until after breakfast put on the stoms and sent him down in the steerage Bar 30-03
Lat Obs 33-31 S Long 164-14 E Eve

Tuesday Feb 15th 1842

There 24 hours light baffling airs and Calm small from NE and different Tacks Bar on 30-02 seized the Steward who not so turbulent as yesterday but would make no promises of going to duty until he got 14 Sec. promised to go to his duty and behave him self sent him in the fore castle to do duty as a sailor
Lat 33-33 S Long 163-35 E Eve

Wednesday

Thursday Feb 16th 1842

Commenced with light airs from NE head to NE middle Calm at 10 AM took a breeze from North steered east by land until 12 Mer Calm again Bar 30-02
Lat 33-18 S Long 164-05 E Eve

Thursday Feb 17th 1842

Commenced with light breezes from West sea. Mid to at day light smart stronger but part moderate breeze from NE fair weather Bar on 30-02 to 12 Mer fell down to that at 6 PM
Lat 33-26 S Long 165-31 E Eve
