Wednesday April 20<sup>th</sup> 1842

These 24 hours a gale from NW to W with the rain pouring down in torrents headed to West Bar 29-06-07

Lat 29-02 Long 163-40 West

Thursday April 21<sup>st</sup> 1842

Begins with a gale at NW rain pouring down at 3 o'clock wind shifted dies away had sea 78 ft took a smart breeze from NW latter the with 24 hours most part clear with some squalls none too under spencers Bar 29-05-06

Lat 28-32 Long 163-46 E

Friday April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1842

Commences with a gale fore part of the night then heavy squalls two under spencers Wind NW with heavy squalls last part moderate had sea Wind NW headed to NW 24 hour Bar on 29-05-06

Lat 28-10 Long 164-35 E

Saturday April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1842

Commences with unsteady breezes and squalls had sea wind NW at 4 o'clock hauled to NW then South compass had sea middle blowing heavy none too headed to the West at 8 o'clock Spenser

Whales came close on board the ship last part gale NW fair weather Bar on 29-05 rose 29-08

Lat 27-54 Long 164-20 E

Pacific Ocean Whaling A Brownell

Sunday April 24<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commences with strong gales from NW and squally middle so latter part quite moderate sea very bad the last 6 days weather very bad headed to west Bar on 29-08 rose to 30-01

Lat 27-46 Long 163-52 E

Monday April 25<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commences with moderate breezes and squalls Middle so latter part moderate and clear Wind NW altered to West Bar 30 to 30-01

Lat 27-45 Long 163-20 E

Tuesday April 26<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commences light baffling Wind from NW fair weather middle light airs and Calms latter part variable winds and squalls with showers and Calms Bar ranged about 30

Lat 27-41 Long 163-10 E

Wednesday April 27<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commences with baffling airs and showers middle and last part fresh gales from NW to WNW clear Bar on 30

Lat 26-49 Long 162-50 E

Thursday April 28<sup>th</sup> 1842

Commences with fresh breezes from NW clear weather Bar began to fall from 30 middle light and baffling from the West Wind latter part steady moderate breeze from NW Bar 29-09

Lat 25-57 Long 162-19 E
